FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your request submitted under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act* 2016 (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 21 March 2018, in which you sought access under the *Freedom of Information Act* 2016 (the Act) to the following information:

"All documents for the period 1 December 2016 to 28 February 2018, including correspondence, emails, notes of meetings and discussions, records of telephone conversations and file notes between (1) the ACT Property Group and the Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA) of Canberra and (2) Access Canberra and the ACT Property Group relating to the request from the YMCA for assistance in relocating their corporate offices from 35 Alexandrina Drive Yarralumla."

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of CMTEDD under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 14 May 2018.

Third Party Consultation

In making this decision, I completed consultation in accordance with section 38 of the Act. The views of identified third parties were taken into account in making this decision.

Decision on access

Searches were completed within CMTEDD for relevant documents and 12 documents have been identified that fall within the scope of point 1 of your request. With regard to point 2 of your request, the original referral from Access Canberra to ACT Property Group

(ACTPG) was made by phone conversation and the search has not identified any documents between Access Canberra and the ACTPG.

I have decided to fully release to you 4 documents and partially release the remaining 8 documents as I consider the redacted information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest to disclose under the test set out in section 17 of the Act.

I have included as <u>Attachment A</u> to this decision the schedule of relevant documents. This provides a description of each document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for each of those documents.

My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as Attachment B to this letter.

In accordance with section 54(2) of the Act a statement of reasons outlining my decision is below.

Statement of Reasons

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- the Act;
- the content of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- the views of relevant third parties; and
- the Human Rights Act 2004.

Exemptions claimed

My reasons for deciding not to grant access to part of the identified documents are as follows:

<u>Information Contrary to Public Interest</u>

The Act has a presumption in favour of disclosure. As a decision maker I am required to decide where, on balance, public interests lies. As part of this process I must consider factors favouring disclosure and non-disclosure.

In Hogan v Hinch (2011) 243 CLR 506, [31] French CJ stated that when 'used in a statute, the term [public interest] derives its content from "the subject matter and the scope and purpose" of the enactment in which it appears'. Section 17(1) of the Act sets out the test, to be applied to determine whether disclosure of information would be contrary to the public interest. These factors are found in subsection 17(2) and Schedule 2 of the Act.

Factors favouring disclosure (Schedule 2 section 2.1)

Taking into consideration the information contained in the documents found to be within the scope of your request, I have identified that the following public interest factors in favour of disclosure are relevant to determine if release of the information contained within these documents is within the 'public interest':

- (a) disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to do any of the following:
 - (ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest; and
 - (viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

Having considered the factors identified as relevant in this matter, I consider that release of the information contained in the documents may contribute to positive and informed debate on the use of the premise at Yarralumla as the headquarters of YMCA Canberra by allowing you to have a record of the interactions between the ACTPG and the YMCA.

The documents include the application from YMCA requesting assistance from the ACTPG for alternative office accommodation. This application and the subsequent communications between ACTPG and YMCA provide background and contextual information that is related to the status of the application and options considered. I am satisfied that the information identified reveals the consideration of the relevant business unit in response to the YMCA's request for government accommodation. I consider there is public interest in increasing transparency of the Directorate and promoting positive and informed debate around particular matters of public interest carries significant weight.

Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2 section 2.2)

As required in the public interest test set out in section 17 of the Act, I have also identified the following public interest factor in favour of non-disclosure that I believe is relevant to determine if release of the information contained within these documents is within the 'public interest':

- (a) disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to do any of the following:
 - (ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the Human Rights Act 2004;
 - (xi) prejudice trade secrets, business affairs or research of an agency or person;

When considering the documents and factors in favour of non-disclosure, I have considered the personal information contained in the documents, including names, signatures and contact information. I am satisfied that the names, signatures, and contact information of government employees should be released as these staff members were acting in their official capacity and the personal information being released is done so in relation to these individuals exercising their delegations in a work related capacity. I do not consider the release of this information is unreasonable or could prejudice their right to privacy.

However, I consider it is unreasonable to release the mobile phone number, residential address and signature of Mr Darren Black, CEO of YMCA Canberra and the name and email address of the Executive Assistant to Mr Black, as this is personal information that is not publicly available. I am of the opinion that release of this information may prejudice the protection of these individuals' right to privacy or any other right under the *Human*

Rights Act 2004. I am satisfied that this factor favouring non-disclosure should be afforded significant weight as it relates to individuals privacy. Accordingly, I have decided to withhold from disclosure mobile phone number, residential address and signature of Mr Black and the name and email address of the Executive Assistant.

Having reviewed the documents identified, I also consider that the release of certain information could prejudice YMCA's business affairs. This includes the rent paid by YMCA for their offices. This information is in relation to the operating costs of YMCA and the release of such information may adversely impact the current and future business activities of YMCA.

Noting the pro-disclosure intent of the Act, I am satisfied that redacting only the information that is not in the public interest to release, while releasing the rest of the documents will ensure the intent of the Act is met and will provide you with access to the majority of information held by CMTEDD within the scope of your request.

Charges

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2)* processing charges are not applicable for this request because the total number of folios to be released to is below the charging threshold of 50 pages.

Your original access application, my decision and documents released to you in response to your access application will be published in the CMTEDD disclosure log after 17 May 2018.
