Background

I was on a bicycle riding down Northborne Avenue towards parliament at a similar pace to a vehicle, a grey SUV (YLL 77S) between 6.40am and 6.50am this morning (26/2/2019). I was on the bike path which has recently been converted to a raised section. I was wearing a high visibility (yellow fluro jacket). I dropped down onto the road consistent with the bike path. The vehicle turned across my path turning from Northborne Avenue into London Circuit (adjacent to the Sydney Building). There was either no or late indication of the vehicle turning. I yelled out, braked and a collision occurred. After colliding with the vehicle I slid down part of the side of the vehicle on my shoulder and hit the mirror.

Police report filed 476CP3.



Justice and Community Safety

Fee Waiver

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 26 February 2019, in which you sought access to all footage held of the intersection of Northbourne Avenue and London Circuit (adjacent to the Sydney Building) from 6.40am to 6.50am 26 February 2019.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 2 April 2019.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant footage and 1 video file has been identified that falls within the scope of your request.

I have included as Attachment A to this decision the schedule of the relevant video file.

I have decided to grant full access to the relevant video file. The video file released to you is provided as **Attachment B** to this letter.

Charges

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2)* processing charges are not applicable for this request because as the video file being be released to you is below the charging threshold.

Online publishing – Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Ombudsman Review
