Summary of Impacts

 The direct sale to BAPS Australian Territories Ltd as Trustee for the BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha (ACT) Trust will enable BAPS to build a facility for purposes of a place of worship; religious associated use, community activity centre and cultural centre to service a section of the Hindu community of the ACT and surrounds.
