Request under the Freedom of Information Act 1989 – RiotACT subscriptions in the Office of the Chief Minister

I refer to your request received by the Chief Minister on 9 July 2014 seeking access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1989 (the FOI Act).

You have requested access to:

- any document containing information about subscriptions to the RiotACT website where such subscriptions are used by staff of the Chief Minister for the period 1 July 2013 to the present;
- In addition, you seek information about which staff have subscriptions, the cost of the subscriptions, the purposes for which the subscriptions have been purchased and the usernames associated with each staff member subscription;

I am the duly authorised decision maker for access to documents of the Chief Minister. A search for official documents within the scope of your request in this office has been conducted. I am satisfied that this search was reasonably sufficient to identify those documents that would have fallen within the scope of your request.

One document has been identified as falling within the ambit of your request and is attached. I have detailed below my formal decision in relation to your request.

Email from Scott Meikle, 29 June 2014 9:13pm to Pat Cronan, Log in. Partial release. Section 41 of the Act provides that a document is exempt if its disclosure would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information about any person. I have decided to redact the log in details contained in this document in that their release would in my view involve unreasonable disclosure of personal information.

You will have 28 days from the date of receiving your decision letter in which to appeal to the Tribunal.
