FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I write in response to your request for access to the Office of Regulatory Services documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act).

In your letter, you sought access to documents regarding Parking Operation Inspections in Staverton Place, Lyons, in particular, you sought access to:

“All documents, information and correspondence held by to ACT Government in relation to Parking Operations Inspections in Staverton Place, Lyons. Without limiting the generality of this request, please provide me with:

- 1. A record complete with dates and times that Parking Operations Officers have completed inspections in Staverton Place in the last 5 years;*
- 2. How many parking infringement notices have been issued in Staverton Place in the last 5 years?”*

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

Although the Act facilitates the objective of public access to documents, access is subject to a number of exemption provisions as set out by the Act. Documents in your request are subject to exemptions as set out by section 41(1) of the Act.

Section 41(1) of the Act details that information may be exempt from release if disclosure under the Act would unreasonably release personal information. I have decided that all photographs are exempt in accordance with section 41(1) of the Act as the photographs may unreasonably identify people or their possessions.

I note that you have requested all documents, information and correspondence in relation to Parking Operation Inspections in Staverton Place, which includes photographs and information in relation to Parking Infringement Notices subject to review. A sample of Parking Infringement Notices subject to review has been provided but heavily redacted due to the amount of personal information included. All Parking Infringement Notices subject to review have not been provided due to majority of the documentation being archived. If you wish to access this information we can provide such documentation, however, the documentation may be heavily

redacted in accordance with section 41(1) of the Act and administration costs may apply due to the size of the request.

Please see the attached schedule detailing what will be released to you.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, not including your original application **will** be published online. You have the right to seek a review of the outcome under section 59 of the Act within 28 days from the date of this letter, or such other period as the Director-General permits.
