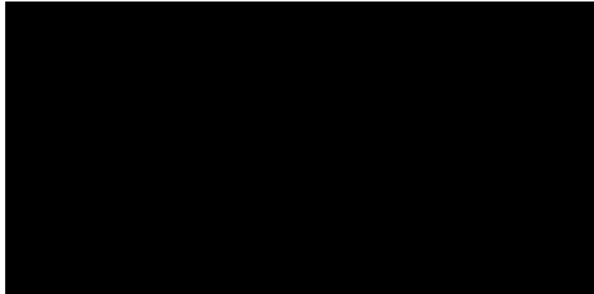

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application received by Access Canberra 11 January 2017 in which you sought access, under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act), to documents relating to:

- Information on all telephone calls or text messages originating from "Access Canberra" to Dial An Ironer phone number 0400097744 on the dates 10/01/2017 and 11/01/2017.
- If any Access Canberra employees have an affiliation with Dial An Ironer; and
- All notes and actions taken for Access Canberra incident submission number 170110-002411 (Parking Operations).

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

In regards to point one, a search of Access Canberra and external telecommunication provider's records has resulted in no records being found in relation to the phone number listed in your request.

In response to your second point, Access Canberra does not capture this information of their employee's and therefore cannot provide the information you have sought. However, all public servants are required to comply with the *ACT Public Sector Management Act 1994* (PSM Act). Under Section 9 of the PSM Act public servants must take all reasonable steps to avoid a conflict of interest and declare or manage a conflict of interest that cannot reasonably be avoided. There have been no disclosures within Access Canberra regarding the Dial and Ironer business.

In response to point three I have decided that the documents are to be fully released in accordance with the Act. Please see the attached schedule detailing what will be released to you.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, not including your original application **will** be published online. 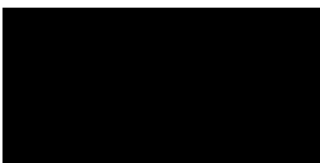
