I write to seek an internal review of the decision made by the Agency to redact information in 167.3.1 of the Land Development Agency's Board meetings' minutes under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989*.

I am seeking a review as I believe that there is a very high level of community interest in this issue, especially in regard to potential legal problems or implications of land sales. The Auditor-General highlighted in *Report No. 3/2018: Tender for the sale of block 30 (formerly block 20) Section 34 Dickson* that a land sale was entered into despite advice from the ACT Government Solicitor's Office outlining legal implications. A copy of that advice was also included in the report. Given previous Auditor-General reports on LDA practices and the well-publicised reviews into governance, I believe there is a high level of public interest in the publication of this information.
