Freedom of Information Request – 17/32936 – File Notes on City to Lake Purchases

I refer to your application under section 14 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (FOI Act), received by the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 23 November 2017, in which you requested the following documents:

“the file notes from David Dawes and Dan Stewart relating to any discussions and meetings they held with government ministers which included discussion on the city to the lake project relating to the purchase of land and businesses at Glebe Park and West Basin (including the boat and bike hire businesses).”

I am an officer authorised to make a decision in respect of a request for information, under section 22 of the FOI Act.

I am writing to advise you that a comprehensive review of records of the former Land Development Agency held or accessible by the City Renewal Authority was undertaken and no documents relevant to your request were identified. Therefore I am satisfied that the Authority is not in possession of any documents relating your request.

Review rights

My decision is appealable under the FOI Act. This means that if you are dissatisfied with this outcome you have a right to seek a review under section 59 of the FOI Act. This right of review extends to a review of the adequacy of the search for documents undertaken. If you wish to seek a review you should write to:
