Formalising the ACT PFAS Action Plan in accordance with the requirements of the Intergovernmental Agreement on a National Framework for Responding to PFAS Contamination (February 2018) (IGA) and the PFAS National Environmental Management Plan (January 2018) (NEMP).

Key to impacts: Red – negative, Blue – neutral, Green – positive.

Justice and rights	 The PFAS Action Plan establishes actions and areas of responsibility to implement the IGA. This will result in a social befit as the IGA establishes the following principals to as the focus of governments when responding to PFAS contamination: precautionary action to minimise human exposure; and Government should be transparent in communication with affected communities and each other.
Economic	
ACT Government Budget	The funding for the PFAS Action plan will be sourced from EPSDD's existing operational budget.
Environmental	
Contamination	 The PFAS Action Plan establishes actions and areas of responsibility to implement the NEMP. The NEMP provides a consistent, practical, risk-based framework for the environmental regulation of PFAS-contaminated materials and sites around Australia. The PFAS Action Plan includes actions that will inform part of a national database on PFAS in Australia with all jurisdiction progressing similar programs in accordance with the IGA and NEMP.
