I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 18 August 2020.

On 3 August 2020 I wrote to you proposing to refuse to deal with your request as it would require an unreasonable and substantial diversion of resources pursuant to section 44(1) of the Act. In that letter you were provided with the opportunity to amend your application. The time allowed for your response to my proposal, as stated under section 46(4)(a), was 10 working days meaning a response was due to this office by 17 August 2020 and I did not receive a response by that date.

Decision on access

I have decided to refuse to deal with your application under section 43(1)(a) as an unreasonable and substantial diversion of resources.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because no pages are being released to you.

Online publishing - Disclosure Log
