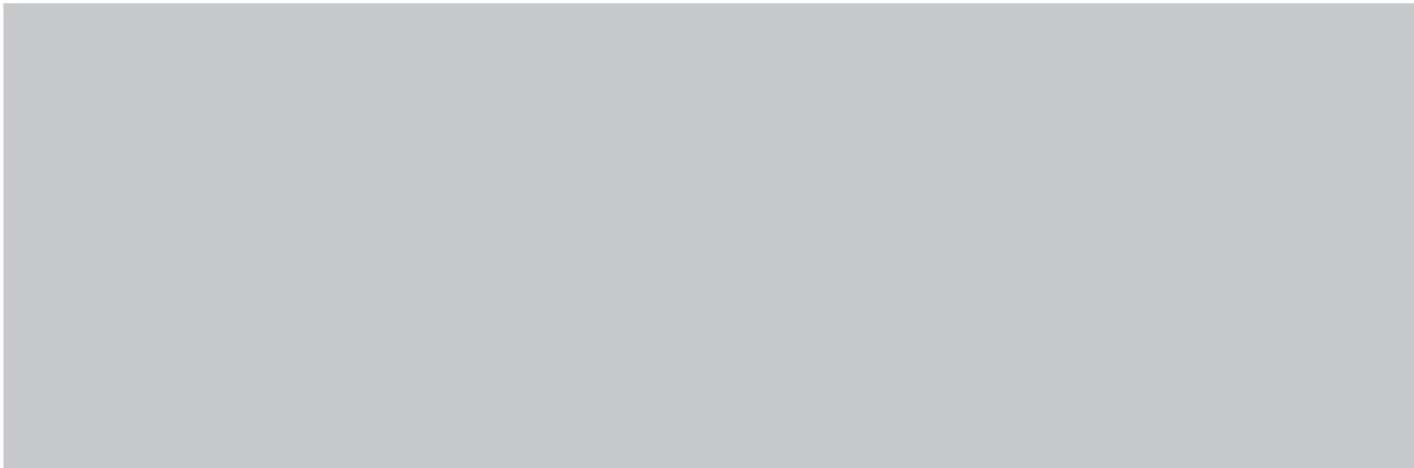

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FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 18 June 2022, in which you sought access to:

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 15 July 2022.

Decision on access

A search of records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request as the ACT Government, specifically Access Canberra, has no involvement with Wilsons Carparks.

The Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) may be able to provide some input regards the building/development covenants.

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by the CMTEDD.

Charges

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2)* processing charges are not applicable for this request because no documents are being released to you.

Online publishing– Disclosure Log
