## **Committees of Cabinet**

A Budget Committee of Cabinet meeting was convened. Treasury officials joined with Ministers to discuss matters of fiscal significance.

## **ICRC Price Determination**

Cabinet considered presentations by both ACTEWAGL and the Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (ICRC) in relation to the Draft Report and Proposed Price Direction – Regulated Water and Sewerage Services, released by the ICRC on 26 February 2013. ## **Liveable Cities Grant: City Strategic Plan**

Cabinet agreed to a City Strategic Plan community consultation process.
