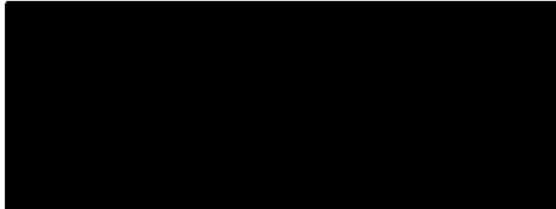

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I write in response to your request for Access Canberra documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act). In your application, you sought access to documents relating to Unit 7 of 39 Kennedy Street Kingston. In particular, you sought access to:

"All documentation (building approvals, changes etc) to do with the history of Unit 7 and the use of common property. Including records allowing Unit 7 the right to use and seal off common property for unit 7's exclusive use"

You further clarified this request to reduce the number of documents, indicating you were interested in any documents relating to the building plan dated 15 September 1992.

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

As the documents held by Access Canberra relevant to your request are more than 20 years old, they are subject to the release provisions of the *Territory Records Act 2002 Part 3* (Access).

The *Territory Records Act 2002* provides a broader range of access to older archival material than outlined in the *Freedom of Information Act 1989*, and as such I have decided that the documents are to be fully released to you. Please see the attached schedule detailing what will be released to you.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, not including your original application **will** be published online. 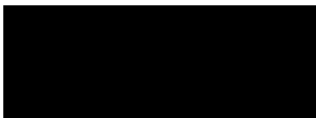
