19-349 ACT Government response to the ACT Services Access Card Report

Summary of Impacts

Implementing the recommendations from the review of the ACT Services Access Card aligns with the ACT Government's commitment to creating an inclusive community where everyone belongs.

The ACT Services Access Card supports eligible asylum seekers to gain access to a range of services without the need to retell their story and demonstrate their eligibility every time they need to access a service or program.

Key to impacts: Red – negative, Blue - neutral and Green - positive.

The ACT Services Access Card (the Card) assist eligible asylum seekers gain smoother access to a range of services without the need to retell their story and demonstrate their eligibility each time they wished to access services or programs.
