I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 25 May 2020, in which you sought access to:

Unpaid fines, by category, under payment plan, under enforcement, awaiting enforcement, total unpaid. Information for f-year 2017/18, 2018/19 and year to date 2019/20, combining data from the infringement office and AFP.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 24 June 2020.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant documents and one document was identified that falls within the scope of your request.

Charges
