FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 4 March 2019, in which you are seeking access to any reports into ACT indoor sporting facilities completed by the Otium Planning Group during the last 12 months.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of CMTEDD under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 2 April 2019.

Decision on access

A search of documents was conducted and resulted in 1 document being identified that falls with the scope of your request.

I have decided to fully exempt the document from release on the basis that it is contrary to the public interest to release under Schedule 1 of the Act.

I have included as <u>Attachment A</u> to this letter a schedule which provides a description of the document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for that document.

In accordance with section 54(2) of the Act a statement of reasons outlining my decision is below.

Statement of Reasons

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- the Act; and
- the content of the document that falls within the scope of your request;

Exemption claimed

My reasons for deciding not to grant access to the identified document is as follows:

Cabinet Information (Schedule 1 of the Act)

The document contains information that was prepared and brought into existence for consideration by Cabinet. The information in this document is to be the subject of Cabinet deliberations.

In reviewing the document, I note the requirements of schedule 1 section 1.6(2) of the Act which states that the exemption for Cabinet Information does not apply to 'purely factual information' unless the disclosure of the information would involve the disclosure of a deliberation or decision of Cabinet and the fact of the deliberation or decision has not been officially published. In the case of *Parnell & Dreyfus and Attorney-General's Department* [2014] AICmr 71, the Australian Information Commissioner stated that the term 'purely factual material' does not extend to factual material that is an integral part of the deliberative content and purpose of a document, or is embedded in or intertwined with the deliberative content in such a manner that it is impractical to separate it from the other content.

Having reviewed the document, I consider that the purely factual information within the document identified is an integral part of the deliberative content and as stated by the Commissioner, the analysis and views in the [documents] would be robbed of their essential meaning without incorporation of this material. I am satisfied that disclosure of this purely factual information would involve the disclosure of a deliberation or decision of Cabinet.

Having considered the information contained in the documents, I am satisfied that disclosure of such information contained in document ref no.1 would be contrary to public interest pursuant to schedule 1 section 1.6 of the Act.

Charges

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2)* processing charges are not applicable for this request because the total number of pages to be released to you is below the charging threshold of 50 pages.

Online publishing - Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. A description of the access application and my decision will be published in the CMTEDD disclosure log after 20 March 2019. Your personal contact details will not be published.

Ombudsman Review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act.
