## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 16 December 2019, in which you sought access to:

Advice obtained by the Chief Minister of the Australian Capital Territory or the
Office of the Chief Minister concerning the legal standing of the City of Canberra
Coat of Arms.

## Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 16 January 2020.

### **Decision on access**

Searches were completed for relevant documents and 14 documents were identified that fall within the scope of your request.

I have included as **Attachment A** to this decision the schedule of relevant documents. This provides a description of each document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for each of those documents.

I have decided to grant access in full to 1 document relevant to your request. I have decided to refuse access to 13 documents as I consider them to be:

contrary to the public interest information under schedule 1.

My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as **Attachment B** to this letter.

In accordance with section 54(2) of the Act a statement of reasons outlining my decisions is below.

#### Statement of Reasons

In reaching my access decisions, I have taken the following into account:

- the Act;
- the content of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;

## **Exemption claimed**

My reasons for deciding not to grant access to the identified documents and components of these documents are as follows:

## Contrary to the public interest information under schedule 1 of the Act

The communications and advice contained within the relevant documents were brought into existence for the dominant purpose of providing a legal opinion. I am satisfied that the communications were made in circumstances of confidentiality and were provided by the Government Solicitors Office (GSO) satisfying the requirements to attract legal professional privilege. Accordingly, I am satisfied that the provisions within section 1.2 of schedule 1 of the Act apply and release of the documents is not within the public interest.

Noting this, the Government response to the Standing Committee on Environment and Transport and City Services regarding the Inquiry into a Territory Coat of Arms is now publicly available and can be found at:

I have decided to grant full access to the remaining one document that falls within the scope of your request.
