I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 22 March 2022, in which you sought access to information in relation to workers compensation insurance of two businesses.
