Freedom of Information Request – Interest declarations

I write in response to your letter of 29 February 2012 regarding your request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act). You have sought all documents held by this Office in relation to interest declarations (including business interests and conflicts of interests) generated during the 7th Assembly.

I am the officer authorised by the Chief Minister to make a decision in relation to your request. Following a thorough search, I can advise you that this Office has four documents which fall within the ambit of your request. I have decided to release these documents in full, and have attached copies of the documents to this letter.

If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of this decision you may appeal to the ACT Civil and Administrative Appeals Tribunal. The Tribunal is an independent body able to agree with, change or reject the original decision, substitute its own decision or send the matter back to the decision maker for reconsideration in accordance with the Tribunal recommendations.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, including your original application and this decision letter, will be published online.
