



ACT Summary of Cabinet Outcomes Government 2 April 2012

As part of the ACT Government's Open Government commitment, this document is a public summary of matters considered by Cabinet. It is not intended to be a detailed set of minutes and does not cover all matters considered by Cabinet. Among matters not covered are materials considered in the formation of the ACT budget, commercial and industrial matters under negotiation, as well as matters that would impact personal privacy, security and the ACT economy. Nothing in this document can be considered a waiver of the Government's executive privilege.

Committees of Cabinet

Two meetings of the Budget Committee of Cabinet were held. Treasury officials joined with Ministers to discuss matters of fiscal significance.

A meeting of the Urban Development Committee of Cabinet was also held. Relevant officials joined with Ministers to discuss matters of development and planning significance.

Review of Processes for the Delivery of Capital Works and Projects Associated with Land Development

Cabinet agreed the ACT Government's response to the Industry Reference Group (IRG) Discussion Paper on *Review of Processes for the Delivery of Capital Works and Projects Associated with Land Development*. Molonglo Valley Stage 2 – Planning and Land Development

Cabinet discussed planning and development matters in relation to Molonglo Valley Stage 2. Molonglo Valley stage 2 is projected to provide new housing for up to 18,000 residents. It will provide a range of housing choice, including affordable housing and land for community facilities.
