





Re: Freedom of Information request

I write in response to the ongoing correspondence between yourself and this office regarding your request for access to the Office of Regulatory Services (ORS) documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act).

In your letter, you sought access to documents regarding parking vehicles and policing parking infringements at McKay Garden Professional Suites in Turner, ACT.

In particular, you sought access to:

“Whatever agreements may exist between McKay Gardens Professional Suites, Turner, and the ACT Government regarding their respective rights, benefits and obligations with regard to vehicle parking within the property...[and] whatever may exist in the way of accounts relevant to the policing of parking infringements at McKay Gardens Professional Suites”.

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

On 19 March 2013, the ORS wrote to you informing you that all of the documents relevant to your request were subject to third party consultation processes in accordance with section 27A of the Act. Third party submissions regarding the release of these documents have since been received.

On review of the attached documents, I have decided to partially release these documents to you, with exemptions, in accordance with section 41(1) of the Act. Please see the attached schedule detailing the documents being released to you.

Section 41(1) of the Act details that information may be exempt from release if its disclosure under the Act would unreasonably release personal information.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy, including your original application and this decision letter, and have determined that the documents **will** be published online.
