I refer to your application under section 15 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (FOI Act), received by the Economic Development Directorate (EDD) by partial transfer from the Chief Minister and Treasury Directorate on 10 April 2013, in which you requested access to the following documents:

- *Any document related to the provision of aviation infrastructure in Canberra that were generated after March 2012 by any part of the ACT Government.*
- *These documents should include any documents related to the Williamsdale airfield proposal.*
- *The documents should include and file notes or other documents related to meetings with aviation bodies or experts.*

I am an officer authorised to make a decision in respect of a request for information, under section 22 of the FOI Act.

### **Decision**

The Directorate has identified a number of documents in its possession that meet the scope of your request, as identified in the schedule attached to this letter. I am releasing all of the relevant documents held by the Directorate to you, although I have decided to exempt some material from release, in accordance with the below mentioned exemption provisions.

### **41 Documents affecting personal privacy**

- (1) A document is an exempt document if its disclosure under this Act would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information relating to the personal affairs of any person (including a deceased person).

The exempt material contains information relating to the personal affairs of a third party.

Please note that some information has been exempt because it was out of the scope of the request (OOS.)

### **Review rights**

My decision is appealable under the Act. This means that if you are dissatisfied with this outcome you have a right to seek a review under section 59 of the Act. This right of review extends to a review of the adequacy of the search for documents undertaken by the Directorate. If you wish to seek a review you should write to:

You have 28 days from the date of this letter to seek a review of the outcome or such other period as the Director-General permits.
