## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST**

I write in response to your letter received by Access Canberra on 6 June 2016 regarding your request for Access Canberra documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act). In your email you sought access to documents regarding complaints made in relation to noise from the Tuggeranong Homestead including what follow-up was made with both complainant and the homestead from 2005 to present.

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

On 27 June 2016, Access Canberra wrote to you informing you that all of the documents relevant to your request were subject to third party consultation processes in accordance with section 27 and section 27A of the Act. Submissions regarding the release of these documents have since been received.

I have decided to partially release these documents to you, with exemptions, in accordance with section 41(1) and section 43(1) of the Act. Please see the attached schedule detailing the documents being released to you.

Section 41(1) of the Act details that information may be exempt from release if its disclosure under the Act would unreasonably release personal information.

Section 43(1) of the Act details that information may be exempt from release if its disclosure under the Act would unreasonably affect business affairs.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, including your original application and this decision letter, **will** be published online. Further redactions were made to the documents released to you to remove all your personal information before publication. A copy of what will be published is also being released to you for your information. For more information about the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy, visit
