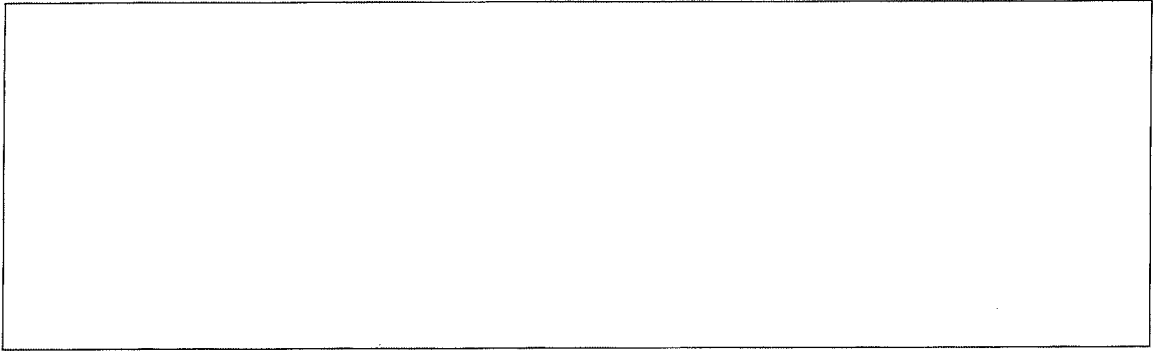
Corrections Officer Report:

On this date from 07:30 Hrs while performing duties as CO1 at the Adult Mental Health Unit (AMHU) Canberra Hospital, Detainee [REDACTED] has escaped custody, In the prior period before the Detainee absconded he was unsecured as per the Security Risk Assessment and Removal Order (SRARO) and continually walking and mingling with other Patients and Health Staff in the common areas and courtyards of the Low Dependency Unit (LDU).

I and Officer [REDACTED] positioned ourselves toward each end of the LDU to monitor movement and keep a visual on the Detainee as per the SRARO .

I was positioned at the entry to one court yard and Officer [REDACTED] at the entry to the other courtyard where I last saw the Detainee enter a few minutes before, at approximately 14:18 hrs Officer [REDACTED] approached me and asked if I had visual of the Detainee, I responded no. We then did a search of the common areas and courtyards and notified AHMU staff who proceeded to do a check of patient rooms.

I exited the AMHU and checked the perimeter while Officer [REDACTED] contacted AMC.

Corrections Officer Report:

Sir,

On this day I was posted to The Canberra Hospital (TCH), Adult Mental Health Unit (AMHU). I arrived at approximately 0710h for a 0730h start, located the AMHU and the correct accommodation area being the smaller of the two accommodation areas where I spoke to the outgoing night shift CO1 [REDACTED] and CO1 [REDACTED]. I was handed a Personal Safety Device and shown the location of Hospital Bag 2 and met some of the AMHU staff. A short time later CO1 [REDACTED] arrived and we both commenced our shift. Detainee [REDACTED] was awake and was pointed out to me walking up and down the corridor and into the single external court yard.

At approximately 0815h AMHU staff advised us that they would take Detainee [REDACTED] into the larger accommodation area at about 0900h, which was next door internally, so he could mingle and interact with more people.

At approximately 0915h Detainee [REDACTED] was taken into the larger accommodation area where he mostly kept to himself and continued to pace up and down the internal common area as well as the accommodation corridors and the each of the three external yards.

The internal common area is approximately 10mts wide and 50mts long. The external exercise yards are approximately 10mt wide at the top entry end, approximately 15mt wide at the far back end, they are approximately 15mts deep to the back fence. The sides of the external yards are flanked by a glassed off corridor along the sides with a roofline approximately 3mts off the ground and a see through rigid security mesh fence approximately 4mts high at the far end of the yard. The external exercise yards are free access via a push button sliding door.

At approximately 1000h Detainee [REDACTED] was taken into a private interview room off the common area by three staff members. When they emerged I had a brief conversation with one of the staff members where he told me that Detainee [REDACTED] would probably not be returned to the AMC today, that he had to be seen by the Forensic Psychiatrist first later on that day, and that they had to still sort out his medication.

Shortly after this I contacted CO3 [REDACTED] (AMC) and advised him that there was a high probability that Detainee [REDACTED] would not be returning to the AMC today, and that I would notify him as soon as I was advised either way.

During the morning Detainee [REDACTED] had free access to the phone for external calls.

At times Detainee [REDACTED] asked to go back to his room to use his toilet then return to the larger area.

At approximately 1040h CO1 [REDACTED] went on a break.

At approximately 1310h I went on a break and returned to the AHMU smaller accommodation area at exactly 1400h.

At approximately 1405h Detainee [REDACTED] asked to go to the larger accommodation area. Upon entering the larger accommodation area CO1 [REDACTED] and I had a brief discussion as to where we could position ourselves so both, or individually, we could keep a constant observation on Detainee [REDACTED]. It was mutually decided that CO1 [REDACTED] would be at the lower end of the common area, and that I observe up from the top (reception, entry/exit) end of the common area so as to cover Detainee [REDACTED] as he walked up and down the common area as well as into the external yards.

At approximately 1410h Detainee [REDACTED] walked past me and into the top external yard, where he paced up and down and along the far end security fence. I had clear and unhindered view of him throughout his whole time in the external yard.

At approximately 1413h Detainee [REDACTED] walked back into the common area, past me within 2mts of where I was seated and down along the common area towards CO1 [REDACTED] position.

As he reached CO1 [REDACTED] I took my eyes off Detainee [REDACTED] and lost contact with him.

At approximately 1417h, after not having sighted Detainee [REDACTED] for a few minutes I walked down to CO1 [REDACTED] and asked him "Have you got him?"

At that time we started a local search in the bottom area including the external exercise

yards. We then widened our search into the lower accommodation corridors and all the little TV and alcove areas. We asked the nursing staff if they had taken Detainee [REDACTED] into one of the interview rooms with a negative response we asked them to help us locate Detainee [REDACTED] by going along the accommodation corridors and search each individual room where we had no access. We then widened our search area again to include the top exercise yards, all the accommodation corridors and rooms, the smaller area where Detainee [REDACTED] was housed overnight and CO1 [REDACTED] started an external search of the building.

At approximately 1430h I advised CO3 [REDACTED] at the AMC that we had lost Detainee [REDACTED] and that we were continuing to actively search the internal and external area of the AMHU for him.

At a later time CO4 [REDACTED] CO3 [REDACTED] and the AFP arrived at AMHU, as well contacting TCH Security.

At a later time we were advised that Detainee [REDACTED] had escaped by climbing over the security fence in the middle external exercise yards.

Sir, I offer this report as my recollection and the extent of my knowledge of Detainee [REDACTED] escape from the AMHU

Sir,

On 04/04/2016 detainee [REDACTED] was transported to the Adult Mental Health Unit (AMHU) at The Canberra Hospital under an emergency order. A Security Risk Assessment and Removal Order was completed as per procedure.

On the 12/04/2016 at 1429hrs I was contacted by CO1 [REDACTED] one of the attending escort officers at AMHU, who advised me that he and CO1 [REDACTED] were unable to locate detainee [REDACTED]. CO1 [REDACTED] advised that he and CO1 [REDACTED] had been searching for the detainee for approximately ten minutes with no success. I asked had the entire facility been searched to which CO1 [REDACTED] advised they were still searching the facility and expected it would take another ten to fifteen minutes to complete this search. I directed CO1 [REDACTED] to contact me immediately when the search is complete or the detainee has been located. I then informed Deputy General Manager [REDACTED] of the situation.

After informing [REDACTED] I contacted CO1 [REDACTED] again and requested an update. I was advised that they were still unable to locate the detainee. I again

directed CO1 [REDACTED] to contact me immediately with any changes in circumstances.

At 1437hrs I contacted the Australian Federal Police (Job # [REDACTED]) and reported the incident.

Compliance Manager [REDACTED] contacted hospital security and reviewed footage from a camera external to a yard off AMHU which showed detainee [REDACTED] scaling an external fence in the corner of the yard at 1416hrs on the Yamba drive side of the AMHU. The detainee headed out of camera view in the direction of the main hospital building. The detainee was unable to be identified on any other footage at that time. It took less than a minute to scale the fence and be out of camera view.

This information was passed on to AFP by the AMHU Security Manager in person onsite at the AMHU. It was confirmed that the detainee was wearing a grey polo shirt, black shorts and black thongs, all appeared to be AMC issue.

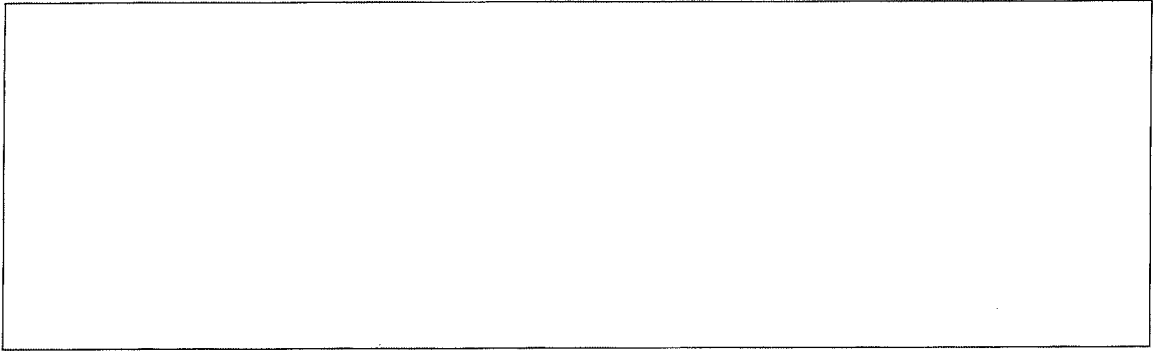

On 04/04/2016 detainee [REDACTED] was transported to the Adult Mental Health Unit (AMHU) at The Canberra Hospital under an emergency order. A Security Risk Assessment and Removal Order was completed as per procedure.

On the 12/04/2016 at 1429hrs I was contacted by CO1 [REDACTED] one of the attending escort officers at AMHU, who advised me that he and CO1 [REDACTED] were unable to locate detainee [REDACTED]. CO1 [REDACTED] advised that he and CO1 [REDACTED] had been searching for the detainee for approximately ten minutes with no success. I asked had the entire facility been searched to which CO1 [REDACTED] advised they were still searching the facility and expected it would take another ten to fifteen minutes to complete this search. I directed CO1 [REDACTED] to contact me immediately when the search is complete or the detainee has been located. I then informed Deputy General Manager [REDACTED] of the situation.

After informing [REDACTED] I contacted CO1 [REDACTED] again and requested an update. I was advised that they were still unable to locate the detainee. I again

directed CO1 [REDACTED] to contact me immediately with any changes in circumstances.

At 1437hrs I contacted the Australian Federal Police (Job # [REDACTED]) and reported the incident.

At this point I had no further contact with the escorting officers.

Compliance Manager [REDACTED] contacted hospital security and reviewed footage from a camera external to a yard off AMHU which showed detainee [REDACTED] scaling an external fence in the corner of the yard at 1416hrs on the Yamba drive side of the AMHU. The detainee headed out of camera view in the direction of the main hospital building. The detainee was unable to be identified on any other footage at that time. It took less than a minute to scale the fence and be out of camera view.

This information was passed on to AFP by the AMHU Security Manager in person onsite at the AMHU. It was confirmed that the detainee was wearing a grey polo shirt, black shorts and black thongs, all appeared to be AMC issue.

When I arrived at [REDACTED] I observed detainee [REDACTED] left arm to have an approximately 10cm open wound but with very little blood flow.

I made a decision to escort detainee [REDACTED] to Hume Health for assessment and treatment by nursing staff.

Nursing staff observed a foreign object in the wound and rang the on call Dr [REDACTED] who advised that the detainee be urgently transported to The Canberra Hospital for treatment.

At 2040 hours I rang the Deputy General Manager [REDACTED] and asked for a removal order to remove detainee [REDACTED] from the AMC to TCH for Treatment.

DGM [REDACTED] gave approval but advised me that [REDACTED] was a potential escape risk and he was to be handcuffed at all times to an officer and this was to be written on the removal order including when receiving treatment unless absolutely necessary and two officers to be with him at all times.

I then escorted [REDACTED] with Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to Admissions to prepare the paperwork for transport to TCH.

At this time I rang the Area Supervisor on duty [REDACTED] at home to ask his advice on the removal of [REDACTED] to TCH as he had dealt with him earlier in the day regarding his arm injury and he advised me that I had followed the correct procedures and to note on the removal order that [REDACTED] was to be handcuffed at all times and to advise escorting staff of this.

After completing all the paperwork and allocating team members [REDACTED] for the escort I advised both of them that [REDACTED] was to be handcuffed at all times including when receiving medical treatment and indicated to them that this had been written on the removal order both acknowledged this.

Before detainee [REDACTED] was escorted to the Admissions sallyport for transport to TCH he asked to use the toilet in Cell 1 Admissions which he did he was then placed in the escort vehicle by CO1 [REDACTED] who was driving the vehicle and CO1 [REDACTED] who used the long handcuffs to secure himself to detainee [REDACTED] in the rear of the escort vehicle at which time I again advised them that [REDACTED] was to remain handcuffed at all times to an officer including during medical treatment unless absolutely necessary.

At approximately 2115 hours the vehicle left the Admissions sallyport enroute to TCH.

At approximately 2210 hours CO1 [REDACTED] called me from TCH to advise that they had arrived at TCH and were in Accident and Emergency ward awaiting assessment all was good and would call back when he had any further updates.

Comments

Detainee is very complex and is monitored by CPSS who have a good understanding of risk issues and his behavioural problems in custody.

Triggers vary but there was no obvious issue leading up to the incident from an officers observational perspective.

On review by CPSS the Detainee mentioned that he had an earlier conflict with another Detainee and this is seen as contributing to the incident increasing stress and anxiety.

He was assessed by CPSS who subsequently consulted Correctional Managers and provided an update of his state of mind and wellbeing.

It was agreed that the injury was not a suicide attempt but part of his complex mindset that is not likely to result in further action at this point.

A collaborative decision was made to place him back in his unit with hourly observations.

Detainee placed on S3 60 x 24 observations and returned to his current unit.

Sir,

On 24th August 2016, I was rostered for night shift at AMC. At about 2030 Hrs, I was informed by CO2 [REDACTED] that I have to escort a detainee to TCH. CO2 [REDACTED] informed me that CO1 [REDACTED] will be the other escorting officer.

I reported to CO2 [REDACTED] at Hume Health Centre where detainee known to me as [REDACTED] was examined by the staff nurses. After finishing first aid on detainee [REDACTED] by the nursing staff, CO2 [REDACTED], CO1 [REDACTED], CO1 [REDACTED] and myself escorted the detainee to the Admissions area and secured him in Holding Cell 1 in Admissions. CO2 [REDACTED] prepared the Removal Order for the detainee and briefed about the detainees previous attempt to escape from custody . CO2 [REDACTED] also reminded myself and CO1 [REDACTED] that the detainee should be hand cuffed all the time.

At about 2115 Hrs. detainee [REDACTED] had been hand cuffed to my left hand and myself with the long hand cuff and [REDACTED] sat on the back seats of the escort vehicle and CO1 [REDACTED] drove the car to TCH. We arrived TCH at about 2130Hrs.and presented [REDACTED] to the induction nursing staff at TCH in the A&E Department. After initial assessment, the nursing staff directed us to be in the waiting area till the doctor

call [redacted] for consultation.

[redacted] and myself sat on a two seat chair in the waiting area and CO1 [redacted] sat on a chair very near to [redacted]. While waiting [redacted] wanted to have his medication and the duty nurse informed him that they are waiting for the Mental Health staff to assess him . At about 2200Hrs. detainee requested to go to toilet, I escorted detainee [redacted] to toilet and remained with him inside the toilet wher the handcuffes remained on both detainee and myself. CO1 [redacted] was waiting outside the toilet. We came back from toilet and resumed the previous position in the waiting area. Later [redacted] requested for something to eat and drink and the nurse issued two sandwiches to him. During all these time, right from the departure from AMC till approximately 2233Hrs. [redacted] was handcuffed to my left hand.

Since I had to go for toilet, I asked CO1 [redacted] to take over the hand cuff from me. CO1 [redacted] took hold on the hand cuffs that was attached to my left hand and took my position near to the detainee. I went the toilet located near to the induction area in A&E Department. At about 2236Hrs. when I came back with a cup of water in my hand, I saw CO1 [redacted] standing near to the entry to Emergency Ward, with a phone in his hand. I couldn't see detainee [redacted] anywhere near to him. I asked CO1 [redacted] about the detainee [redacted] and CO1 [redacted] informed me that detainee [redacted] escaped from custody.

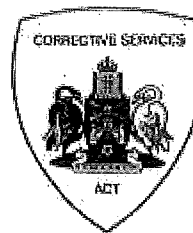
CO1 [redacted] informed AFP and CO2 [redacted] about the escape from custody by detainee [redacted]. At about 2240 Hrs. CO1 [redacted] and myself conducted a search for the detainee about side A7E area and the car park. We couldn't find [redacted] anywhere. As per the instruction from CO2 [redacted], we remained in TCH. At about 2310Hrs. 2 AFP officers came to us , CO1 [redacted] explained about the incident to the AFP officers. I handed over the Episode summery and removal order to one of the AFP officers for their ready reference. At this point of time the AFP officers received a radio call from somewhere and they left the location. At about 2330Hrs. CO1 [redacted] contacted CO2 [redacted] for further instruction and CO2 [redacted] asked us to report back to AMC. We arrived AMC at about 2350Hrs.

Corrections Officer Report:

Sir.

On the 25/08/16 I was rostered on as CO1 nightshift, I started off in Women's/X-ray. I was asked by CO2 [REDACTED] to attend health as they were escorting Detainee [REDACTED] to health as he had cut his wrist open.

I was then informed after arriving at health that I would be required to transport the Det to Canberra hospital to have his wrist looked at.

At this stage we escorted the Det to admissions and secured him in cell 01 whilst the paperwork was completed for the transfer.

At this stage I was informed that he was a potential flight risk and to keep him cuffed at all times.

We left the AMC at approx 2115 and arrived at the Canberra hospital shortly after. After registering our details at the front desk we were asked to take a seat in the waiting room.

Det [REDACTED] asked if I could approach the nurse and ask for his mental health medication, I proceeded to the counter and relayed the request to the nurse.

At all time the Det was handcuffed to CO1 [REDACTED]

A short while later he had asked for some food I again asked the nurse if they could accommodate this request to which they agreed.

AT approx 2235 CO1 [REDACTED] stated that he needed to go to the toilet and proceeded to cuff him to me. This was done using the long chained cuffs.

After a few minutes the Det asked if he could go to the toilet to take a dump, I took him to the toilet area which is located just off to the side of the nurses' station and in plain sight of the reception waiting area. I took a look inside the toilet and concluded that there was nowhere to cuff him inside the toilet. The toilet itself was small and there was no obvious ways of getting out except through the toilet door itself. I uncuffed him so he could do his business with some degree of privacy.

At this time a Nurse arrived and said she had some medication for [REDACTED] I called out to the Det, and informed him that his medication had arrived.

As he came out he started to grab his medication and as I was about to handcuff him again he shoved past the nurse and bolted towards the front entrance.

I gave chase out the front doors and after realizing that I was never going to catch him I immediately rang CO2 [REDACTED] and advised him of the situation, I then rang the AFP and advised them of what had happened.

In retrospect I should never have taken the cuffs off the Det and should have waited for CO1 [REDACTED] to return. I accept full responsibility for my actions and am deeply regretful of the way I have let down CO2 [REDACTED], Co1 [REDACTED], DGM [REDACTED] and ACT corrections in general.

Corrections Officer Report:

Sir,

At approximately 2020 hours today 24.08.2016 while performing my duties as the AMC Night Senior I was summoned to attend Sentenced Unit one Cell [REDACTED] in response to detainee [REDACTED] advising MCR that he had injured his arm and was hearing voices. When I arrived at SA-4 I observed detainee [REDACTED] left arm to have an approximately 10cm open wound but with very little blood flow. I made a decision to escort detainee [REDACTED] to Hume Health for assessment and treatment by nursing staff. Nursing staff observed a foreign object in the wound and rang the on call Dr [REDACTED] who advised that the detainee be urgently transported to The Canberra Hospital for treatment. At 2040 hours I rang the [REDACTED] and asked for a removal order to remove detainee [REDACTED] from the AMC to TCH for Treatment. DGM [REDACTED] gave approval but advised me that [REDACTED] was a potential escape risk and he was to be handcuffed at all times to an officer and this was to be written on the removal order including when receiving treatment unless absolutely necessary and two officers to be with him at all times. I then escorted [REDACTED] with Officers [REDACTED] to

Admissions to prepare the paperwork for transport to TCH.

At this time I rang the Area Supervisor on duty [REDACTED] at home to ask his advice on the removal of [REDACTED] to TCH as he had dealt with him earlier in the day regarding his arm injury and he advised me that I had followed the correct procedures and to note on the removal order that [REDACTED] was to be handcuffed at all times and to advise escorting staff of this.

After completing all the paperwork and allocating team members [REDACTED] for the escort I advised both of them that [REDACTED] was to be handcuffed at all times including when receiving medical treatment and indicated to them that this had been written on the removal order both acknowledged this.

Before detainee [REDACTED] was escorted to the Admissions sallyport for transport to TCH he asked to use the toilet in Cell 1 Admissions which he did he was then placed in the escort vehicle by CO1 [REDACTED] who was driving the vehicle and CO1 [REDACTED] who used the long handcuffs to secure himself to detainee [REDACTED] in the rear of the escort vehicle at which time I again advised them that [REDACTED] was to remain handcuffed at all times to an officer including during medical treatment unless absolutely necessary.

At approximately 2115 hours the vehicle left the Admissions sallyport enroute to TCH.

At approximately 2210 hours CO1 [REDACTED] called me from TCH to advise that they had arrived at TCH and were in Accident and Emergency ward awaiting assessment all was good and would call back when he had any further updates.

At approximately 2240 hours CO1 [REDACTED] called from TCH to advise me that [REDACTED] had escaped and "done a runner" I asked him how this could have happened because he had been told to handcuff him at all times and CO1 [REDACTED] stated to me that he had uncuffed the detainee to go to the toilet and nursing staff had asked to give [REDACTED] medication who had then come out of the toilet pushed the nurse aside and run off.

I advised CO1 [REDACTED] to immediately begin a search of the area to find the detainee [REDACTED] and to call the AFP and Hospital security for assistance.

I then called DGM [REDACTED] at approximately 2245 hours to advise him of the incident. I submit this report for your information.
