The internal common area is approximately 10mts wide and 50mts long. The external exercise yards are approximately 10mt wide at the top entry end, approximately 15mt wide at the far back end, they are approximately 15mts deep to the back fence. The sides of the external yards are flanked by a glassed off corridor along the sides with a roofline approximately 3mts off the ground and a see through rigid security mesh fence approximately 4mts high at the far end of the yard. The external exercise yards are free access via a push button sliding door. At approximately 1000h Detainee was taken into a private interview room off the common area by three staff members. When they emerged I had a brief conversation with one of the staff members where he told me that Detainee would probably not be returned to the AMC today, that he had to be seen by the Forensic Psychiatrist first later on that day, and that they had to still sort out his medication. Shortly after this I contacted CO3 (AMC) and advised him that there was a high probability that Detainee would not be returning to the AMC today, and that I would notify him as soon as I was advised either way. During the morning Detainee had free access to the phone for external calls. At times Detainee asked to go back to his room to use his toilet then return to the larger area. At approximately 1040h CO1 went on a break. At approximately 1310h I went on a break and returned to the AHMU smaller accommodation area at exactly 1400h. At approximately 1405h Detained asked to go to the larger accommodation area. Upon entering the larger accommodation area CO1 and I had a brief discussion as to where we could position ourselves so both, or individually, we could keep a constant It was mutually decided that CO1 observation on Detainee would be at the lower end of the common area, and that I observe up from the top (reception, entry/exit) end of the common area so as to cover Detainee as he walked up and down the common area as well as into the external yards. At approximately 1410h Detainee walked past me and into the top external yard, where he paced up and down and along the far end security fence. I had clear and unhindered view of him throughout his whole time in the external yard. At approximately 1413h Detainee walked back into the common area, past me within 2mts of where I was seated and down along the common area towards CO1 position. As he reached CO1 I took my eyes off Detainee and lost contact with him. At approximately 1417h, after not having sighted Detainee for a few minutes I walked down to CO1 and asked him "Have you got him" At that time we started a local search in the bottom area including the external exercise

yards. We then widened our search into the lower accommodation corridors and all the

AFP Job Number – advised 1437hrs
Compliance Manager and Operations Manager attended the AMHU.
Compliance Manager contacted hospital security and reviewed footage from a camera external to a yard off AMHU which showed detained scaling an external fence in the corner of the yard at 1416hrs on the Yamba drive side of the AMHU. The detainee headed out of camera view in the direction of the main hospital building. The detainee was unable to be identified on any other footage at that time. It took less than a minute to scale the fence and be out of camera view.
This information was passed on to AFP by the AMHU Security Manager in person onsite at the AMHU. It was confirmed that the detainee was wearing a grey polo shirt, black shorts and black thongs, all appeared to be AMC issue.

AFP Job Number – advised 1437hrs
Compliance Manager and Operations Manager attended the AMHU.
Compliance Manager contacted hospital security and reviewed footage from a camera external to a yard off AMHU which showed detained scaling an external fence in the corner of the yard at 1416hrs on the Yamba drive side of the AMHU. The detainee headed out of camera view in the direction of the main hospital building. The detainee was unable to be identified on any other footage at that time. It took less than a minute to scale the fence and be out of camera view.
This information was passed on to AFP by the AMHU Security Manager in person onsite at the AMHU. It was confirmed that the detainee was wearing a grey polo shirt, black shorts and black thongs, all appeared to be AMC issue.



Comments

Detainee is very complex and is monitored by CPSS who have a good understanding of risk issues and his behavioural problems in custody.

Triggers vary but there was no obvious issue leading up to the incident from an officers observational perspective.

On review by CPSS the Detainee mentioned that he had an earlier conflict with another Detainee and this is seen as contributing to the incident increasing stress and anxiety.

He was assessed by CPSS who subsequently consulted Correctional Managers and provided an update of his state of mind and wellbeing.

It was agreed that the injury was not a suicide attempt but part of his complex mindset that is not likely to result in further action at this point.

A collaborative decision was made to place him back in his unit with hourly observations.

Detainee placed on S3 60 x 24 observations and returned to his current unit.

A short while later he had asked for some food I again asked the nurse if they could accommodate this request to which they agreed.						
AT approx 2235 CO1 stated that he needed to go to the toilet and proceeded to cuff him to me. This was done using the long chained cuffs.						
After a few minutes the Det asked if he could go to the toilet to take a dump, I took him to the toilet area which is located just off to the side of the nurses' station and in plain sight of the reception waiting area. I took a look inside the toilet and concluded that there was nowhere to cuff him inside the toilet. The toilet itself was small and there was no obvious ways of getting out except through the toilet door itself. I uncuffed him so he could do his business with some degree of privacy.						
At this time a Nurse arrived and said she had some medication for out to the Det, and informed him that his medication had arrived. As he came out he started to grab his medication and as I was about to handcuff him again he shoved past the nurse and bolted towards the front entrance. I gave chase out the front doors and after realizing that I was never going to catch him I immediately rang CO2 and advised him of the situation, I then rang the AFP and advised them of what had happened.						
In retrospect I should never have taken the cuffs off the Det and should have waited for CO1 to return. I accept full responsibility for my actions and am deeply regretful of the way I have let down CO2 CO1 DGM and ACT corrections in general.
