

## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 8 November 2019, in which you sought access to:

# Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of CMTEDD under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### **Timeframes**

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 6 December 2019.

## **Decision on access**

Searches were completed for relevant documents and 60 documents were identified that fall within the scope of your request.

I have decided to refuse access to all identified documents under s13 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* as the records are covered under the *Territory Records Act 2002*.

# Release of documents under Territory Records Act 2002

All of the documents identified as within the scope of your request are over 20 years old and therefore are subject to the access provisions under section 26 of the *Territory Records Act 2002*. Section 26 states that:

- (1) A record of an agency is open to public access under this Act on the next Canberra Day after the end of 20 years after the record, or the original of which it is a copy, came into existence.
- (2) A person is entitled to access under this Act to a record of an agency that is open to public access.

I have considered the documents in the *Building file relating to*and I have decided that these records are able to be released to you in full.

# Online publishing - Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and my decision in response to your access application will be published in the CMTEDD disclosure log after 3 December 2019. Your personal contact details and the documents provided to you under the *Territory Records Act 2002* will not be published. ## **Ombudsman Review**

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in CMTEDD disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
