## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – NOTICE OF DECISION

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate and transferred to the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD). This transfer was accepted by CMTEDD on 30 January 2024. Specifically, you have sought access to the following information:

documents relating to the properties:

Entire building files, including but not limited to, all building applications, plans, photographs, building consents, asbestos repairs (if any) and any document which refers to "asbestos", "limpet asbestos", "sprayed asbestos", "A/C", "fibro", "corrugated AC", "Super Six", "Deep Six", "Hardiflex", "Duraflex", "Hardiplank", "Wunderplank", "compressed A/C", "fibro pipes" and/or "A/C pipes". The relevant time period for the request is 1960 to the current date.

On 9 February 2024 you agreed to rescope the request to:

any document which refers to "asbestos", "limpet asbestos", "sprayed asbestos", "A/C", "fibro", "corrugated AC", "Super Six", "Deep Six", "Hardiflex", "Duraflex", "Hardiplank", "Wunderplank", "compressed A/C", "fibro pipes" and/or "A/C pipes".

## Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the CMTEDD Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### **Timeframes**

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application within 30 days. Therefore, a decision is due by 13 March 2024.

### **Decision on access**

A search of CMTEDD records has failed to identify any documentation that falls within the scope of your access application. I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by CMTEDD.

Please note, that under section 13, this Act does not apply to records that a person is entitled to access under the *Territory Records Act 2002*, part 3, including those that are over 20 years old.

## **Charges**

Pursuant to Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2) processing charges are not applicable for this request as no documents are being released to you.
