I refer to your reduced scope request (the request) under the ACT *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act) received by the Economic Development Directorate (EDD) on 21 December 2012.

You sought access under the Act on behalf of [REDACTED] for documents held by the Directorate relating to Block 10 Section 64 Lyneham in the Australian Capital Territory.

I am an officer authorised to make a decision in respect of a request for information, under section 22 of the FOI Act.

#### **Decision**

As per your discussion with the EDD Freedom of Information Coordinator on Friday, January 11 2013, the Directorate holds no documents relating to criteria one and three of your request in which you sought access to:

1. *A copy of all applications by Tennis ACT Limited to the Economic Development Directorate for government grants from 2008 to date, with respect to premises located at Block 10 Section 64 Lyneham in the Australian Capital Territory; and*
3. *A copy of all plans, budgets and all related documents filed by Tennis ACT Limited with the Economic Development Directorate in support of any applications for government grants from 2008 to date, with respect to premises located at Block 10 Section 64 Lyneham in the Australian Capital Territory.*

In relation to criteria two of the request in which you sought access to:

2. *A copy of all grants issued by the Economic Development Directorate to Tennis ACT Limited from 2008 to date, with respect to premises located at Block 10 Section 64 Lyneham in the Australian Capital Territory.*

The Directorate has identified a document in its possession relating to this request, as identified in the schedule attached to this letter. I am releasing the relevant document held by the Directorate to you, although I have decided to exempt some material from release, in accordance with the following exemption provision:

#### **41 Documents affecting personal privacy**

- (1) A document is an exempt document if its disclosure under this Act would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information relating to the personal affairs of any person (including a deceased person).

The exempt material contains information relating to the personal affairs of a third party.

#### **Review rights**

My decision is appealable under the Act. This means that if you are dissatisfied with this outcome you have a right to seek a review under section 59 of the Act. This right of review extends to a review of the adequacy of the search for documents undertaken by the Directorate. If you wish to seek a review you should write to:

You have 28 days from the date of this letter to seek a review of the outcome or such other period as the Director-General permits.
