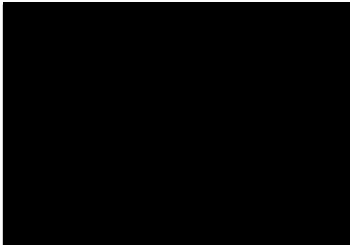

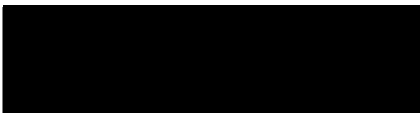

Thank you for your email of 4 June 2016 about the selection of the Athllon Drive point to point camera site. I apologise for the delay in responding to you.

The Athllon Drive site was selected based on previous work by AECOM, an independent engineering consultant, in which consideration was given to potential point to point camera locations based on a 50:50 weighting of safety and traffic factors. Athllon Drive met the relevant criteria at the time and in relation to the safety factors it ranked second only to the Hindmarsh Drive site. This assessment took into account 2004 to 2008 crash data during which time there were 456 crashes on Athllon Drive, including two fatal crashes.

The forward design study and subsequent site analysis was completed when road safety cameras was the portfolio responsibility of the Attorney-General, Mr Simon Corbell MLA. Regarding your question about stakeholder consultation, a stakeholder reference group was formed for this project which included the involvement of NRMA Motoring and Services and relevant ACT Government agencies.

A recent review of the ACT's road safety camera locations confirmed Hindmarsh Drive as being suitable for point to point cameras, pending future evaluation, but the suitability of Athllon Drive was questioned because it is interrupted by two roundabouts. The problem with having roundabouts in a point to point enforcement area is that they substantially reduce the average speed between the two detection points on the road and reduce the effectiveness and deterrence effect of the cameras as the road environment itself contributes to compliance.


Having intersections within a point to point camera area also means that traffic can enter and exit the area without being detected by the cameras. For example, in May 2016, just 22% of the southbound traffic (Beasley Street to Drakeford Drive) and 32% of the northbound traffic (Drakeford Drive to Beasley Street) travelled the entire length of the enforcement area (ie. between the two detection points). This means that 78% of the southbound traffic and 68% of the northbound traffic could avoid detection by the point to point camera.

A feasibility study will now be commissioned to examine the practicalities of relocating the Athllon Drive cameras to an alternate location. This study will investigate the Tuggeranong Parkway, Parkes Way and the new Majura Parkway as these roads all have the characteristics of a point to point camera site.

I expect this feasibility study will be completed by the end of the year. On the basis that this work confirms the suitability of an alternative site for point to point cameras it would be used for a future capital works budget bid to support relocation of the cameras. The study will include advice on any costs to relocate the cameras including any additional equipment which may be required at a new site.

Thank you for raising this matter with me. I trust this information is of assistance.

Ben has put together a draft site assessment report, which I am reviewing.



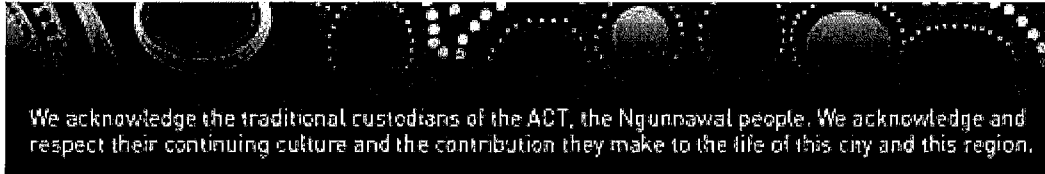

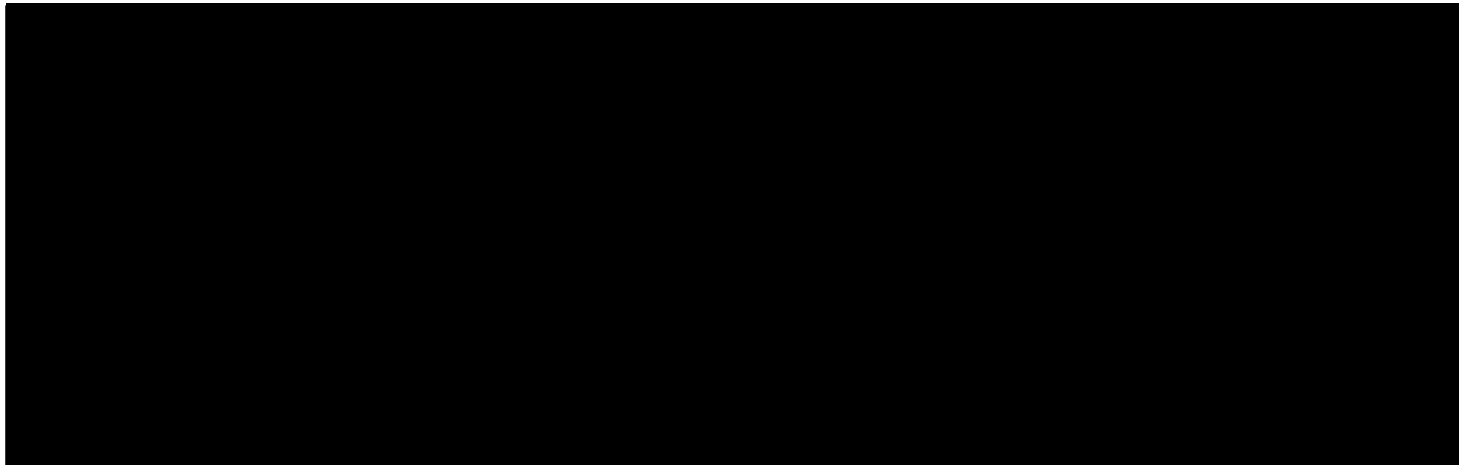

As you can see from the email trail below, our initial contact with Gatso has been referred onwards to Cary Laue in the ACT Government and he is unaware of the project.



Your (P2P) cameras are currently installed at two location in the ACT, Hindmarsh Drive and Athllon Drive. The Athllon Drive cameras will be removed in the near future and the reuse of these cameras at an alternative site is being explored. The ACT government is interested in comparing the feasibility of relocating the existing cameras vs. decommissioning these cameras and installing new cameras at the newly identified site.

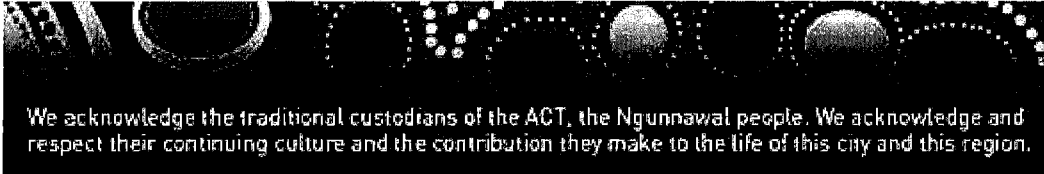

The data types required are:

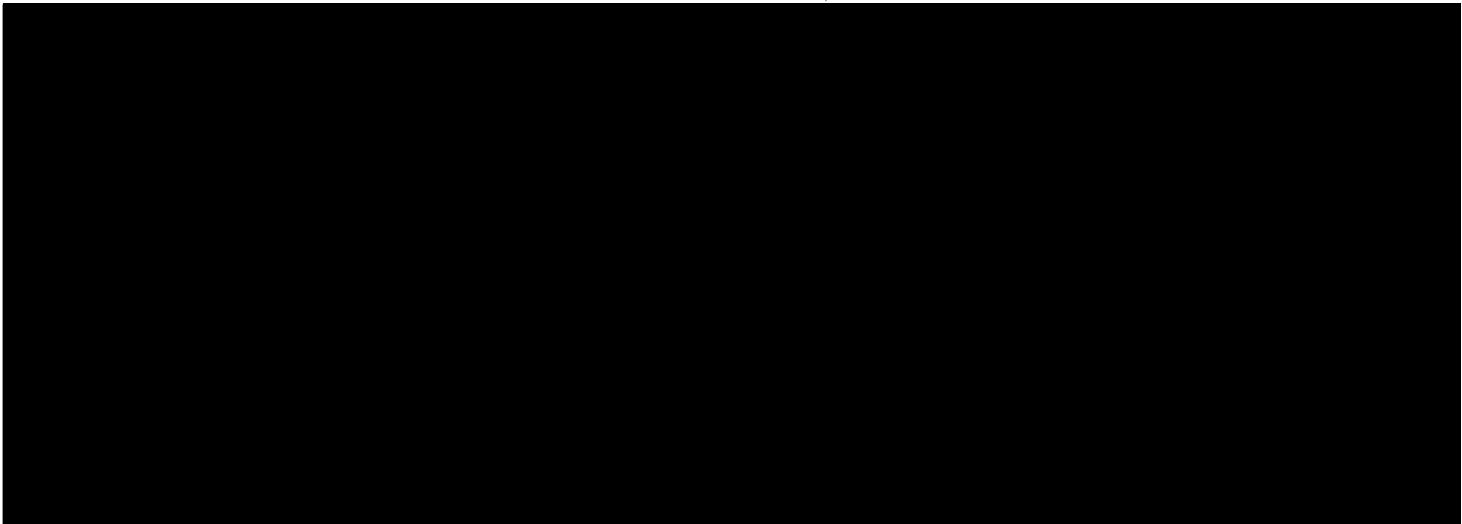
- Crashes:

1 - TERM

2 - THE SUPPLIES

The Supplies are to be a report which provides advice on the practicalities of relocating the existing point to point camera system on Athllon Drive to an alternate location. The three candidate routes for assessment are Tuggeranong Parkway, Parkes Way and Majura Parkway.

In assessing the feasibility of each of these alternate routes, the advice is to include:

- engineering suitability of each route
- physical suitability of locations along each route
- cost of relocating the camera system to the preferred site.

Areas of particular consideration for the assessment include:

- Investigating the impact that traffic churn (i.e. vehicles entering and exiting the P2P camera zone between the two detection points) would potentially have on the effectiveness of the proposed relocation site.
- Recommending the best option/s for reducing any identified impacts (e.g. shortening the enforcement area to reduce the number of vehicles that would avoid detection).

In addition, the report is to extend to providing advice about:

- Information Technology risks associated with relocation of the P2P camera equipment, including any possible redundancies given the age of the equipment and the evolving nature of technology in this area.
- Opportunities for using the P2P camera system for both speed enforcement and heavy vehicle monitoring and enforcement.
- If the preferred relocation site for the P2P camera system includes an existing fixed mid-block speed enforcement camera system/s, then advice is required on the relocation of those camera systems in accordance with the relevant points, above.

- 3.3 If the Territory rejects any Supplies, the Supplier must, at no cost to the Territory and within any timeframe specified by the Territory, remove the Supplies (in the case of goods) and:
- (a) replace any rejected Supplies that are goods; and
- (b) re-perform any rejected Supplies that are services; or
- (c) refund any payment for the rejected Supplies.
- 3.4 If the Territory does not reject the Supplies within 14 days of receiving the Supplies, the Territory is taken to have accepted the Supplies.
- 4. Title and Risk**
- Risk of loss and damage and title in Supplies that are goods passes to the Territory on its acceptance of those goods.
- 5. Warranty**
- For Supplies that are goods, the Supplier must:
- (a) during any warranty period specified in the Contract, without delay and at no cost to the Territory, correct all defects in the Supplies by way of repair, replacement or such other means acceptable to the Territory; and
- (b) ensure, to the extent practicable and permitted by law, that the Territory receives the benefit of any warranty given by a third party with respect to any goods,
- however:
- (c) this does not in any way relieve the Supplier of any obligation or warranty by it under this Contract; and
- (d) the Supplier is liable for all costs incidental to the discharge of any warranty under this Contract.
- 6. Ownership and use of material**
- 6.1 Ownership of:
- (a) all Contract Material, including any intellectual property rights, vests on its creation with the Territory;
- (b) all Territory Material, including any intellectual property rights, remains with the Territory; and
- (c) all Support Material, including any intellectual property rights, remains the property of the Supplier.
- 6.2 The Territory grants to the Supplier a royalty-free, limited licence to use the Contract Material and Territory Material for the term specified in the Contract.
- 6.3 The Supplier:
- (a) grants to the Territory, a perpetual, royalty-free licence to use the Support Material to the extent necessary for the Territory to obtain the full benefit of the Supplies; and
- (b) warrants that the Territory's use of any Contract Material and Support Material under this Contract will not infringe the intellectual property rights of, or create any obligations in connection with, any third party.
- 6.4 The Supplier must safeguard and preserve Contract Material and Territory Material in its possession or control and deliver to the Territory all Contract Material and Territory Material on expiration or termination of this Contract (other than copies that the Territory authorised the Supplier to retain).

7. Supplier's Personnel

The Supplier must, in providing the Supplies:

- (a) engage only persons who have the skills, training and expertise appropriate for the Supplies; and
- (b) comply with all reasonable requirements notified by the Territory regarding suitability and fitness of persons engaged for the provision of the Supplies.

8. Non-disclosure of Territory Information

The Supplier must:

- (a) use Territory Information held in connection with this Contract only for the purposes of fulfilling its obligations under this Contract;
- (b) not transfer Territory Information held in connection with this Contract outside the Territory, or allow any person (other than its authorised personnel) outside the Territory to have access to it, without prior written approval of the Territory;
- (c) notify the Territory immediately if the Supplier becomes aware that a disclosure of Territory Information may be required by law or any unauthorised disclosure of Territory Information has occurred; and
- (d) in respect of any Personal Information held in connection with this Contract:

9. Confidential Text under the Procurement Act

9.2 Except as provided in this Contract, the Territory must not disclose confidential text specified in the Contract to any person without the prior written consent of the Supplier (which consent will not be unreasonably withheld) except to the extent that the confidential text:

- (a) is required or authorised to be disclosed under law;
- (b) is reasonably necessary for the enforcement of the criminal law;
- (c) is disclosed to the Territory's solicitors, auditors, insurers or advisers;

- (d) is generally available to the public;
- (e) is in the possession of the Territory without restriction in relation to disclosure before the date of receipt from the Supplier;
- (f) is disclosed by the responsible Minister in reporting to the Legislative Assembly or its committees; or
- (g) is disclosed to the ombudsman or for a purpose in relation to the protection of public revenue.

10. Indemnity

The Supplier indemnifies the Territory, its employees and agents against all liability in respect of all claims, costs and expenses in relation to all loss, damage, injury or death to persons or property caused by the Supplier, in connection with the provision of the Supplies, except to the extent that the Territory caused the relevant loss, damage or injury.

11. Termination

The Territory may terminate this Contract in part or whole, at any time by notice to the Supplier, if the Supplier:

- (a) enters, or in the Territory's absolute opinion, is likely to enter, into any form of external administration or makes any arrangement with its creditors or takes advantage of any statute for the relief of insolvent debtors;
- (b) fails to provide the Supplies within, or to meet any other, timeframes or milestones specified in this Contract; or
- (c) is otherwise in breach of a provision of this Contract, where that breach:
 - (i) if capable of being remedied, is not remedied within the period specified in a notice by the Territory, or
 - (ii) is not capable of being remedied.

12. Conduct in Territory Premises

The Supplier must, when using Territory premises or facilities, comply with all reasonable directions of the Territory.

13. Notices

Any notice or communication under this Contract will be effective if it is in writing, and delivered to the other party. A notice will be deemed to have been delivered:

- (a) if delivered by hand, on delivery;
- (b) if sent by prepaid mail, on the expiration of two business days;
- (c) if sent by facsimile, on the sender's facsimile machine recording that the facsimile has been successfully and properly transmitted to the recipient's address; or
- (d) if sent by electronic mail, on the other party's acknowledgement of receipt by any means.

14. Assignment and Subcontracting

The Supplier must not assign or subcontract any of its rights or obligations under this Contract without the prior written consent of the Territory. If the Territory gives its consent, the Territory may impose any conditions.

15. Survival

Clauses 6, 7 and 8 of this Contract survive the termination or expiration of this Contract.

16. Applicable Law

The laws of the Australian Capital Territory apply to this Contract.

17. Variation

This Contract may be varied only by the written agreement of the parties prior to the expiration of the Contract.

18. Entire Agreement

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement of the parties in relation to the provision of the Supplies and all other agreements, warranties and representations are excluded.

19. Definitions and Interpretation

"Contract Material" means all material created, written or otherwise brought into existence as part of, or for the purpose of providing the Supplies including all reports (whether in draft or final form), documents, information and data stored by any means.

"Information Privacy Act" means the *Information Privacy Act 2014 (ACT)*.

"Invoice" means an invoice that:

- (a) if GST is payable in respect of the provision of the Supplies, is a valid tax invoice for the purposes of the *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999 (Cth)*;
- (b) clearly sets out details of the Supplies provided and of the amount that is due for payment, is correctly calculated and is in respect of Supplies provided in accordance with this Contract;
- (c) is accompanied by any other details or reports required under this Contract; and
- (d) is rendered at the time/s specified in clause 2.2.

I just wanted to give you an update on progress of the project and run past you an initial outline we have in mind for the report.

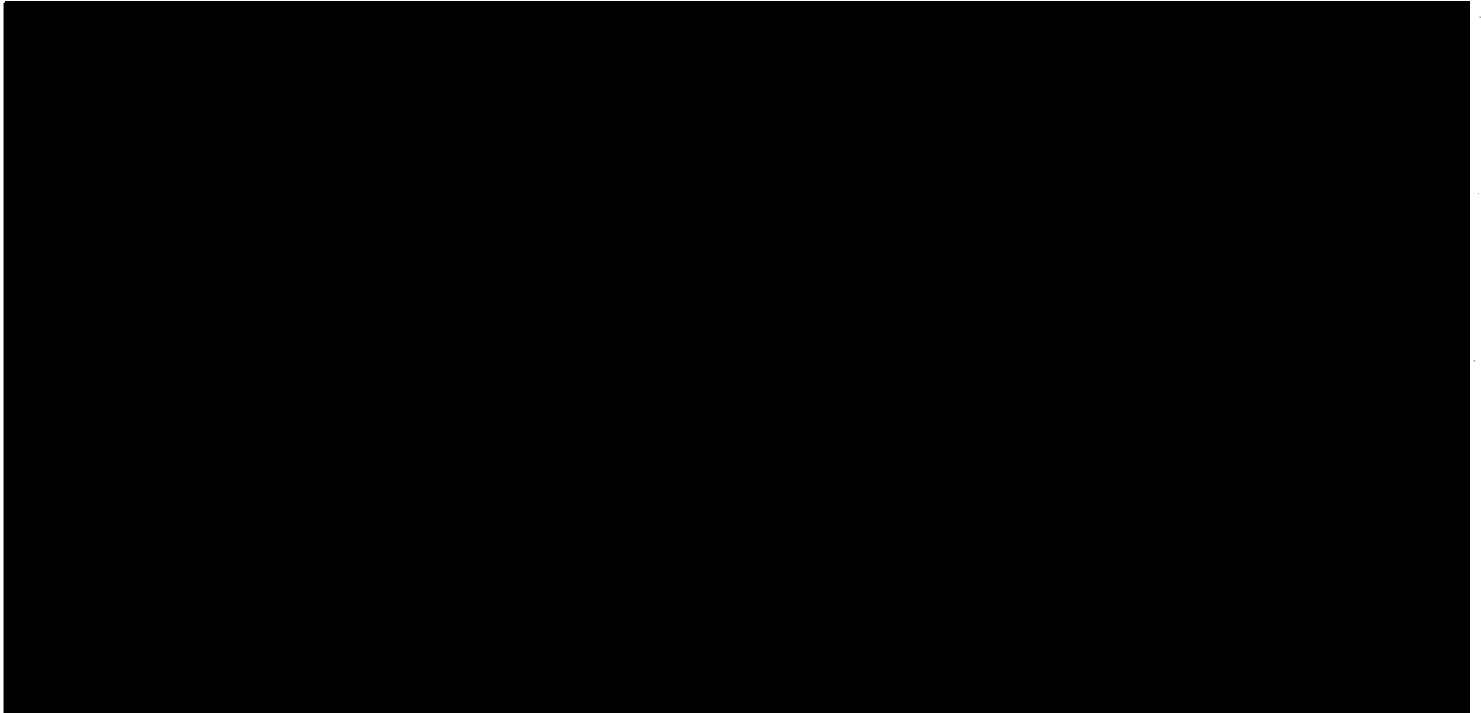

2. The green units are the roadside servers, they hold the data that is then uploaded to the matching server here at Dickson. The servers on the roadside hold the previous 14 days worth of images and data. 14 days is the legislated timeframe for the retention of non-offence images. The units also have connection to the National Measurement Institute time server.
3. At the entry point, the loops initiate images of the vehicle, before the SPD (Shortest Practical Distance) line marked on the road, the system then chooses the best image and starts the time measurement. At the exit and after the SPD line, the loops initiate images and again the system will choose the best image and end the time measurement.
4. An indication of infringement rates and vehicle counts are in the attached spread sheets. We are no longer completing these, and the more recent figures might be dodgy due to operator input errors.
 - b. While the spread sheet for Athllon will provide a count of vehicles at entry and exit, I cannot determine from this how many of those vehicles undertook the complete trip. I cannot answer this point with any authority.
 - c. The attached spread sheet for 2012 shows vehicle counts and infringements prior to the go live date of 27 February 2012. This shows the drastic reduction in speeding offences.
 - d. I cannot answer this point.
