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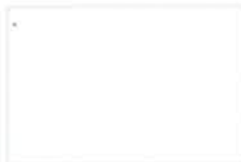

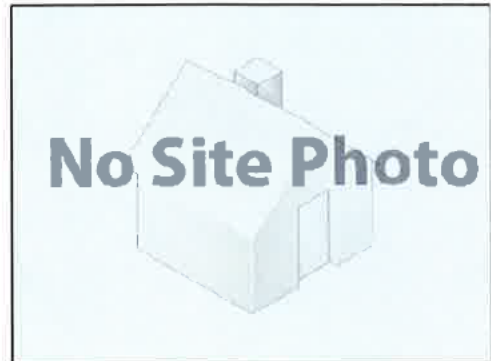

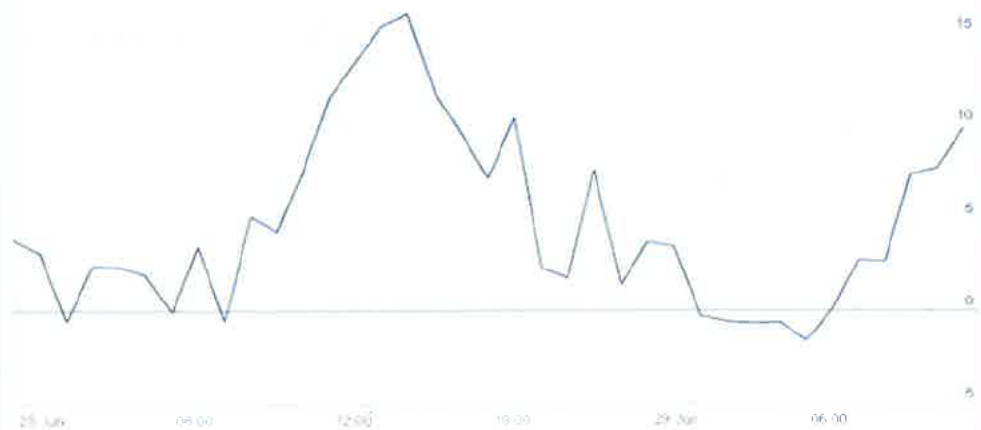

Further to my below email. The relevant section of the BEPM relating to cover is on page 42, section 7.7 with the required outcomes being and I quote:

- “Covering of the waste, at least daily, with soil or another approved cover material for all sites that accept putrescible waste and maintain the cover.
- Close cracks in old, exposed cover layers to contain landfill gas and odour.
- No use of acid sulfate soil as daily cover.”

The NSW solid waste guidelines provide further guidance on cover material on page 51 section 8 which is mainly the use of VENM for cover material. They provide further guidance on the use of alternate cover material which requires a trial to be undertaken to ensure that it can clearly be demonstrated that the alternate material can perform to meet site conditions etc. EQ may well adopt these guidelines when reviewing a request to use alternate day cover.
