Minister's Office Feedback

Background

1. On 1 August 2017, the Canberra Branch of the Master Builders Association (MBA) wrote to you requesting a meeting to discuss the Local Jobs Code with its s 41 s 41 and s 41
2. The MBA is the nation's peak building and construction industry association, with national membership of over 32,000 businesses. Currently the Canberra branch of the MBA has membership of over 1,200 businesses. Membership ranges from large multi-national commercial builders to individual contractors and sole traders.

Issues

3. As you would be aware, there have been ongoing tensions between the MBA,

UnionsACT and the CFMEU. The MBA have been on the record publically over their concerns regarding the *Memorandum of Understanding on Procurement of Works and Services by the ACT Government (MoU)* between the ACT Government and UnionsACT.

4. During the 2016 Territory election the MBA denounced the MoU, saying it gave unions undue influence on public sector building projects. ^{s 41} [REDACTED] called for an end to the agreement stating 'the ACT Government must move to scrap the MoU and return the Territory to a competitive commercial tender process' at Attachment A.
5. An article published on the MBA's website on 15 September 2016 stated that 'Territory law requires that anyone tendering on ACT Government work must have a current Industrial Relations and Employment Certificate (IRE). This transparent, audited benchmark quite correctly demands that employers honour their legal and ethical industrial relations obligations'.
6. The article went on further to say 'The established robust processes protect workers. Secret, conflicted demands from an organisation with vested commercial interests do not. The MoU simply allows the CFMEU to circumvent this fair and transparent process replacing facts with innuendo and concocted rumour in pursuit of their own commercial interests'.
7. Given the MBA's views on the current MoU, it is likely they will have concerns regarding the Local Jobs Code which has been described in the Canberra Times as legislating the MoU (Attachment B).
8. It is likely, that even if the ultimate content of the Local Jobs Code achieves desirable outcomes, the MBA and other employer groups would not support the reforms given early negotiations on its design are exclusively taking place between the Government and unions.
9. The union/CMTEDD advisory group which is developing a consultation draft Local Jobs Code is unlikely to recommend changes that would create a conflict between ACT law and the Commonwealth's building code. In addition, it is likely that the ACT proposal will feature an expanded IRE regime. The cumulative impact of these two features would, if implemented, limit potential disruption to the construction industry and establish more transparent procurement arrangements.

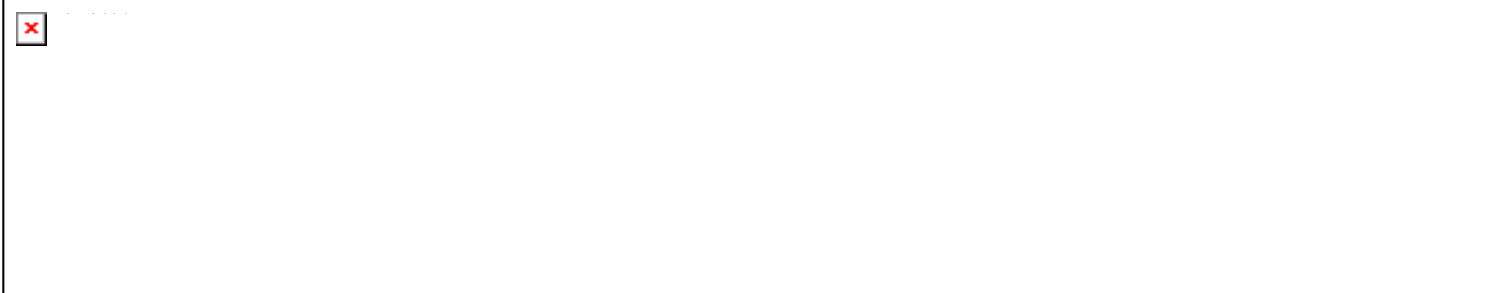

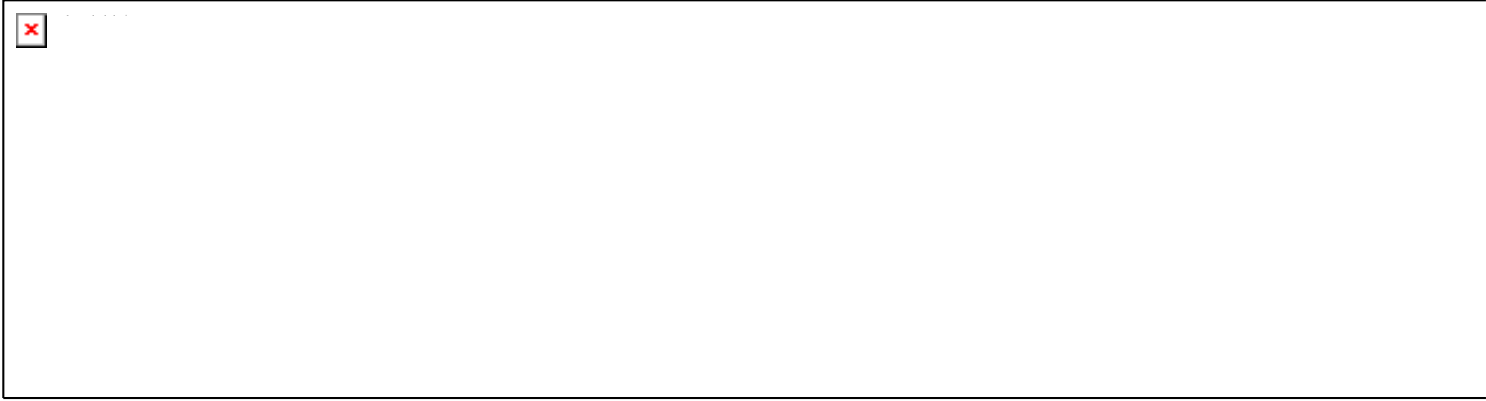
