




LGBTIQ Inclusive Canberra 2017-18 FINAL REPORT

- This web based survey opened 23/10/2017 (this report prepared 20/12/2017)
- Promoted on Ministerial Advisory Council Facebook page, ACT Queer email list and various other social media channels
- Paper version of survey distributed on Spring Out Fairday (with over 100 responses on Fairday alone)
- There were 284 responses

78% think Canberra is either friendly or very friendly for LGBTIQ people

We asked you to pick on a scale of 1 (very unfriendly) to 5 (very friendly), how LGBTIQ friendly you think Canberra is currently.




We gave some suggestions of policies/initiatives that might make an inclusive city. Respondents were asked to tick any that were important to them personally.

More people (72%) wanted existing *general* social and support services adapted to ensure they include LGBTIQ people, compared to 61% who wanted more social and support services *specifically* for LGBTIQ people

Also, 71% wanted staff at **local government organisations and service providers to have LGBTIQ awareness training**


The most popular initiatives (and maybe this was because the survey was conducted during Spring Out) were **more events**, scheduled throughout the year, and **LGBTIQ visibility** in everyday life.
