19/188 Workers Compensation Amendment Bill 2019 (relates to 19/189 Workers Compensation Amendment Bill 2019)

Summary of Impacts

The proposed Bill would:

- reduce administrative overheads in relation to the registration of workers' compensation lump sum settlement agreements with the ACT Magistrates Court;
- ensure equitable access to workers' entitlements from the Default Insurance Fund;
- ensure workers' compensation coverage for approved family day care service providers and approved in-home care service providers; and
- address inconsistencies in the Workers Compensation Act 1951 (WC Act).
