FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your applications under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 26 January 2021.

Specifically you sought:

The ACT Government is now operating red light cameras to issue automatic infringements to drivers who enter an intersection after the traffic lights have turned red. These are accompanied by signage to indicate the presence of a camera. I believe that some infringements may have been issued by these cameras before the signage was in place, and if so I think this would be of public interest. I would like to access documents that detail the installation dates of cameras and related signage, and documents that show the number of infringements issued by cameras where signage had not yet been installed. These may be separate documents detailing the installation and operating dates of cameras and signage, and the number of infringements issued by camera by day. I would also like to access documents, such as ministerial briefs and related items, which outline the ACT Government's policy on the use of signage to indicate the presence of such cameras. I believe these documents may be held by different directorates, so I have submitted this request to CMTEDD, TCCS, and JACS.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 23 February 2021.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant documents and one document was identified that fell within the scope of your request. I have decided to grant full access to the relevant document. The document released to you is attached to this letter. Note that as the Red Light cameras do not issue infringements some of your questions are not valid. I understand the additional information relating to signage is being provided by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) in response to this request that you also sent to them.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because the number of pages to be released to you is below the charging threshold of 50 pages.

Online publishing - Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and the document released to you in response to your access application will be published in the CMTEDD disclosure log 3 days after the date of my decision. My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act.  safety Red Light Cameras do not automatically issued infringements. All red light and speed
 offences are adjudicated by an authorised officer under the Road Transport (General) Act 1999.
- These are accompanied by signage to indicate the presence of a camera. I believe that some
 infringements may have been issued by these cameras before the signage was in place, and if so I
 think this would be of public interest.
