To progress this project, it is proposed to undertake the forward design during 2009/10 and progress the construction works during 2010/11 and 2011/12. The project would be delivered as part of the capital works program.

Implementation Issues

It is important to progress the forward design and environmental impact assessment during 2009/10 given the scale of the project and the sensitive environment of the Black Mountain precinct.

The forward design process will also confirm the adequacy of the project funding.

Funding for the forward design will be sought as part of the 2009/10 capital works program.

Proposed Consultation

A public information session will be conducted in Belconnen Town Centre and a presentation will be made to the Belconnen and Gungahlin Community Councils at the preliminary design stage.

The community and special interest groups will have opportunities to comment at an early stage in the process.
