Thank you for your email received in this office on 16 February 2012 in which you sought access under the 'Freedom of Information Act 1989' (the Act) to the following material:

'All correspondence, including emails, between the offices of the ACT Human Rights Commission and ACT Greens MLAs, their offices and staff from November 2008 to the present time.'

I am the officer authorised under s.22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request. Please find attached a schedule of the documents the Commission holds that fall within your request. I believe that some are exempt from the Act, and I have provided details of which section of the Act applies in the attached schedule.

Please be aware that under the ACT Government's Online FOI Publication Policy, information released under this Freedom of Information application may be released on the internet. Please note that personal information or business affairs information will not be made available under this policy. A copy of the policy, with details about what information may be published on the internet, is available online at http://www.cmd.act.gov.au/open_government.

My decision is appealable under the FOI Act. This means that if you are dissatisfied with this outcome you have a right to seek a review under Part 7 of the Act. Generally, such reviews must be sought within 28 days.

Under section 54 of the Act, if you are concerned about the processing of your request or related administrative matters, you may complain to the Ombudsman, who may conduct an independent investigation into your complaint. There is no fee for this service:
