Dear Phil

The Education and Training Directorate will be requesting Minister Burch to make a determination on the following non-government school applications for In-principle Approval:

1. Canberra Christian School is seeking to build an additional campus to be located in the new Molonglo development. The proposal states that the campus is proposed to open in 2015 catering for students from kindergarten to year 6; eventually expanding to year 12. A potential site for this campus has been identified by the Economic Development Directorate.
2. Brindabella Christian College (BCC) is seeking to develop an additional campus on the site of the former Charnwood High School which is now owned and used by Charnwood Christian Life Centre. BCC is currently licenced by the Community Services Directorate to operate an early learning centre on this site. The proposal states that the campus is proposed to open

in 2014 catering for students from kindergarten to year 4; eventually expanding to year 12.

3. Canberra Muslim Youth is seeking to build and/or develop a new school to be located in Gungahlin or Belconnen. The proposal states that the school is proposed to commence in 2014 catering for students from kindergarten to year 4; eventually expanding to year 10. A potential site for this school has not yet been identified by the Economic Development Directorate.

I expect that these briefs will arrive in the Ministers office early next week. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you require any further clarification.
