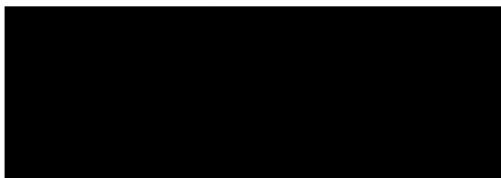

Freedom of Information Request – Canberra Brickworks and Environs Planning and Development Strategy 2015

I refer to your request made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act) for access to documents relating to the Canberra Brickworks.

Specifically, you are seeking:

- all submissions including late submissions, to the Brickworks and Environs Planning and Development Strategy 2015 except for the following which we already have: Submissions from: YRA , ISCCC, Deakin Residents, NCAA, Weston Creek community council, Australian institute of Landscape architects, friends of grasslands, See-change inner south, National Trust, Molonglo catchment group, Pedal Power ACT, Living Streets Canberra, Janet Thomson Architects, Patrick Stein architect, Lane-Poole Place Yarralumla residents.

Decision Maker

I am authorised under section 22 of the Act to make decisions on access to documents and liability for charges.

Charges

I have decided, under section 29 of the Act, not to impose processing charges for this request.

Identification of Documents

Officers from the Land Development Agency have conducted searches for documents that relate to your request. A number of documents have been located and are detailed in the attached schedule.

Decision on Access

As you are aware from my letter of 5 August 2015, I have been consulting with a number of third parties under sections 41 (personal privacy) and 43 (business affairs) of the Act about the possible exemption from release of information contained in documents relevant to you request.

I have decided to release to you all of these documents in part, as outlined in the attached schedule, and a copy of each is enclosed.

Exemptions claimed

Documents Affecting Personal Privacy

Section 41 of the Act provides:

- (1) *A document is an exempt document if its disclosure under this Act would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information about any person (including a deceased person).*

Under section 41(1) of the Act, I have exempted personal information such as names, signatures, addresses and personal references to individuals to protect the privacy of the people concerned.

Your Right of Review

Internal Review

Under section 59 (1) of the Act, you may request a review of my decision. You have 28 days after receiving notice of my decision to ask for a review, or a further period as allowed by the Chief Executive Officer.
