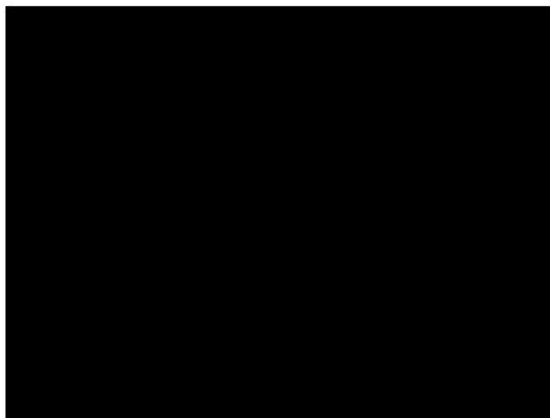

Freedom of Information Request

I refer to your access request under section 14 of the ACT *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 15 November 2017.

You requested:

Decision Maker

I am authorised under section 22 of the Act and have been approved to make decisions on access to documents and liability for charges.

Charges

I have decided, under section 29 of the Act, not to impose processing charges for this request.

Identification of documents and decision on access

Directorate officers have identified all documents that formed the briefing packages provided to the Chief Minister for the Public Accounts Committee 2016-17 Annual Report hearings on 10 November 2017. These briefing documents were also provided to the Director-General and the Under-Treasurer as relevant.

I have decided to release all relevant documents to you in full.

I have released the relevant components of the indexes that prefaced each briefing package. Some topics contained within the indexes are not relevant to the Public Accounts Committee Annual Report Hearing and this information has been redacted. The topic titles have been retained for reference.

I understand you have submitted a separate FOI request to Icon Water Limited (Icon) which is being considered by Icon. For this reason I have not considered any briefs prepared by Icon as part of this request, although they were included in the Chief Minister's briefing package.

Your right of review

Internal Review

Under section 59(1) of the Act, you may request a review of my decision. You have 28 days after receiving notice of my decision to ask for a review, or a further period as allowed by the Director-General.
