FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 20 September 2018, in which you sought access to documentation associated to inquiry #180607-002030.

Specifically, you are seeking:

"The submission relates to the Access Canberra question with reference number #180607-002030 (referred to subsequently as the inquiry). Comments/annotations, attachments, or documentation associated with the inquiry. A report, screenshot or documentation of the staff who viewed, were assigned to handle or contributed responses to the inquiry. Any emails received or sent by staff who viewed, were assigned to handle or contributed responses to the inquiry, including but not limited to B. Gough of Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate, relating to the inquiry, [REDACTED] or "Security Researcher".

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 19 October 2018.

Decision on access

A search of CMTEDD records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request. The search was conducted using the information you provided, including searches of digital and hard copy records.

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by CMTEDD.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request as no documents were found.


