FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on **4 February 2023**, in which you sought access to:

"I seek access to all the documents leading to and including the decision to name the public holiday "Sovereign's Birthday". The time period of this request is this ACT parliamentary term."

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 3 March 2023.

Decision on access

A search of CMTEDD records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request. The search was conducted using the information you provided.

Please see the information below, provided by the relevant business unit to provide you with some additional context:

Public holidays observed in the ACT, which includes the national public holidays found under the national Fair Work laws, are set out in the <u>Holidays Act 1958</u> (ACT) (Holidays Act). These holidays are listed on the <u>CMTEDD webpage</u>, sourced from the legislation.

While the website has been updated to no longer refer to the June public holiday as the "Queen's birthday", the reference to "Sovereign's birthday" has been used relying on section 3(1)(x) of the Holidays Act which has been in place since it was first made as a Commonwealth Ordinance in 1958 (refer the Holidays Ordinance 1958 (Cth)). Given this, there has been no decision to change the name of this June public holiday.

Material considered

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- the Act
- the information that falls within the scope of your request.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because no documents are being released to you.

Online publishing - Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log.
