Freedom of information request

I refer to your request under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act) received by the Territory and Municipal Services Directorate on 29 January 2013, in which you sought access to information and statistics relating to the culling of kangaroos in Canberra nature reserves from 1990 to 2012.

I am authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

Right of review

If you are still dissatisfied after the directorate has conducted an internal review, you may seek an independent review of the decision by the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal. You have 28 days from the date of the internal review decision to seek a review from the tribunal.

Ombudsman

You also have the right to complain to the Ombudsman about the processing of your request. If you wish to lodge a complaint with the Ombudsman, you should write to:
