I refer to your request (the request) under section 15 of the ACT *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act) received by the Economic Development Directorate (EDD) by partial transfer from the Territory and Municipal Services Directorate (TAMSD) on 1 February 2013.

You sought access under the Act to documents relating to the contract for the construction of the 'North West Intersections Cotter Road/Kirkpatrick St' road works in Weston.

In particular you sought access to the following:

"My request is for a copy of the latest document that discusses whether the penalty clause should be invoked and a penalty applied. I am only interested in the relevant portion of the document, if it happens to be part of a larger document. If the latest discussion is, for example, in an email exchange I am happy to adjust the request accordingly".

I am an officer authorised to make a decision in respect of a request for information, under section 22 of the FOI Act.

Decision

The Directorate has identified a number of documents in its possession that meet the scope of your request, as identified in the schedule attached to this letter. I am releasing all of the relevant documents held by the directorate to you. Please note that some information in the released documents has been redacted because it was out of the scope of the request.

Review rights

My decision is appealable under the Act. This means that if you are dissatisfied with this outcome you have a right to seek a review under section 59 of the Act. This right of review extends to a review of the adequacy of the search for documents undertaken by the Directorate. If you wish to seek a review you should write to:

You have 28 days from the date of this letter to seek a review of the outcome or such other period as the Director-General permits.

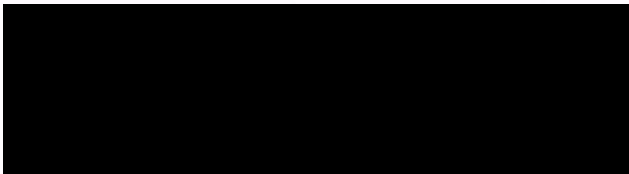
