FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 14 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (FOI Act), received by the Justice and Community Safety Directorate on 2 July 2013, in which you requested the following documents:

In the last 12 months:

- *Statistical reports held or generated by the Alexander Maconochie Centre Intelligence Unit regarding needle/syringe finds for last 12 months*
- *Statistical reports held or generated by the Alexander Maconochie Centre Intelligence Unit regarding tattoo gun finds for last 12 months*
- *Statistical reports held or generated by the Alexander Maconochie Centre regarding needle stick injuries for last 12 months*
- *Statistical reports held or generated by the Alexander Maconochie Centre regarding detainee sexual activity for last 24 months*
- *Statistical reports held or generated by the Hume Health Centre regarding Hepatitis C infection and transmission rates for last 24 months.*

I am the officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

As outlined in our letter of 4 July 2013, documents held by the Hume Health Centre with respect to point five above are the responsibility of the Health Directorate. The Health Directorate have processed this request under a partial transfer and provided documentation as per the attached letter.

Please also be advised that a search of ACT Corrective Services holdings did not produce any documentation with respect to point four of your request.

I have decided that documents with regard to point one, two and three are to be fully released, with the exception of information that is out of scope. Please see the attached schedule detailing what will be released to you.

I have also assessed your request for information under the ACT Government's Online Freedom of Information Publication Policy and have determined that the documents relevant to your request, not including your original application and this decision letter, **will** be published online.
