



RE: Request under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989*

I refer to your email of 18 July 2014, seeking access to data under the ACT *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act) held by the ACT Revenue Office in relation to First Home Owner Grants.

In your request, you have sought:

- *The number and value of First Home Owner Grants paid since 1 January 2013.*
- *Information on a monthly or annual basis since 1 July 2000 is being sought.*
- *We are not seeking any personal or property address details, nor any other information that could potentially identify an individual.*

I have conducted a review of all data held by the ACT Revenue Office relating to your request. I am authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

The two attached Excel documents identify:

- The number and value of First Home Owner Grants paid since 1 January 2013 per dwelling type; and


