The request is pointed at Access Canberra, Parking Ops has not had any contact and TCCS are responsible for Road Signs.

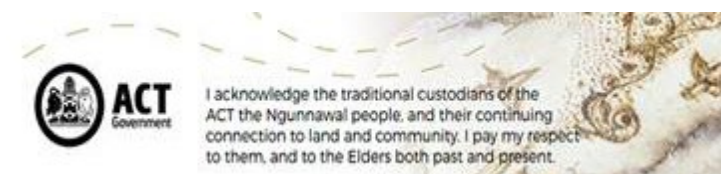

### **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 11 February 2019, in which you sought access to any correspondence regarding parking signage in Coombs.

Specifically, you are seeking any correspondence by Access Canberra to residents at Laurana Terraces (John Gorton Drive, between Gustin Street and Daly Avenue, Coombs 2611) regarding removal of a No Parking sign adjacent to Laurana Terraces on John Gorton Drive.

#### **Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### **Timeframes**

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 12 March 2019.

#### **Decision on access**

A search of CMTEDD records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request. The search was conducted using the information you provided.

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by CMTEDD.

#### **Charges**

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2017 (No 2)* processing charges are not applicable for this request as no documents within the scope of your request were found.
