## Summary of impacts:

- It is not considered that there are any direct negative impacts on the ACT community arising from the review of the operation and effectiveness of ICOs
- It is anticipated that there may be positive impacts on the ACT community in relation to supporting people on an ICO, to improve timeliness when an ICO assessment is ordered, address their drug and alcohol dependence issues and reinforces a rehabilitative approach to sentencing, thereby assisting in reducing recidivism.
- Agreeing to release the Review Report ensures the community is aware of the ongoing consultation that will be undertaken, with a view to amending legislation in the future.
