FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 9 March 2022, in which you sought access to:

A copy of any correspondence (including but not limited to emails, email attachments, and letters) from and to the Executive Chief of Staff Mr Michael Cook (from the 1st of January 2018 until 1st of January 2021), regarding Chinese Government investment in infrastructure in the ACT.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 11 April 2022.

Decision on access

A search of records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request.

The search was conducted using the information you provided including but not limited to the terms "*Chinese Government*", "*Chinese*", and "*Chinese*" and "*Infrastructure*".

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by the CMTEDD.
