FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application, submitted on behalf of your client, under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 8 August 2023, in which you sought access to:

- i. Any information relating to Block 5 Section 2 Division of Hall ACT ("Property") that would ordinarily be provided by WorkSafe ACT via the former Dangerous Substances Search.
- ii. Specifically, any information relating to dangerous substances present on the Property caused by the three to four underground fuel storage tanks that once existed on the Property.
- iii. Confirmation of the previous locations of the three to four underground fuel storage tanks that once existed on the Property.
- iv. Confirmation of whether an environmental assessment was conducted on the Property following removal of the underground fuel storage tanks.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of CMTEDD under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 20 September 2023.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant information and seven documents, and three spreadsheet entries were identified that fall within the scope of your request.

However, six of these items fall outside of the Act as they are more than 20 years of age. Under the Territory Records Act, section 26:

- (1) A record of an agency is open to public access under this Act on the next Canberra Day after the end of 20 years after the record, or the original of which it is a copy, came into existence.
- (2) A person is entitled to access under this Act to a record of an agency that is open to public access.

In accordance with section 13 *Relationship with Territory Records Act 2002*, the FOI 'Act does not apply to a record of an agency if a person is entitled to access the record under the *Territory Records act 2002'*.

To not delay your access to these records, I have liaised with the CMTEDD Records Manager, who has examined the information and is satisfied they are in the open period and do not include information that falls within the terms of a section 28 exemption. Therefore, these items can be released to you under the *Territory Records Act 2002*.

I have included as **Attachment A** to this decision the schedule of relevant items. This provides a description of each document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for each of those documents.

I have decided to grant full access to the remaining items. All items being released to you are provided as **Attachment B** to this letter.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because less than 50 pages are being released.

Online publishing - Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the Act, CMTEDD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and documents released to you in response to your access application will be published on the CMTEDD disclosure log after 21 September 2023. Your personal contact details will not be published. You may view CMTEDD disclosure log at https://www.cmtedd.act.gov.au/functions/foi

Ombudsman Review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in CMTEDD disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.

Thank you for the application for a records search for Block 5 Section 2, Cnr Gladstone & Victoria Streets Hall ACT.

I have conducted a search of the Dangerous Substances Register and hold no records for Block 5 Section 2 Hall.

However under the Dangerous Goods Database I located a license which possibly relates to the site, as you can see the street address does not contain a street number and the information from you that the tanks were removed and the holes filled with sand. I have attached a screen shot of this license for your information. I attempted to have 4 files located from archives which may have held information relevant to the site, this was unsuccessful.

(Please note: Under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1975* (1975 to April 2004), tanks of 50,000 litres which contained Diesel were not required to be licenced with WorkCover, only if the capacity was 50,001 litres).




