We signed a contract about a week ago to have Access Economics do a financial feasibility study on Williamsdale (\$50k + GST). This builds on a desk-top study done by them for the Canberra Region Aviators Association. We have commissioned them to undertake the survey work to back up the 'numbers' report that they did, to put a value on the public interest element of the proposal (mostly increased capability for fire-fighting in the Tinderries), and to put some meat around the economic multipliers for the Territory. This is a "threshold" study - we did the physical feasibility for the site some years ago, which indicated that it was suitable for the proposed operations; this study will determine whether there it is financially viable (either operationally, or capital cost and operations) and

whether the Government has a valid reason to get involved. Assuming it passes this test, we then have to look at the ActewAGL solar farm activity and whether it will count out GA operations. *Then*, and only then, will there be any reason to ask Government for project support – assuming it passes all the previous tests. 2012 at the earliest, I would guess.
